













Instructions:

Print pages on white cardstock. Cut out each equation page as well as the cover and back pages.

Open the seed packet(s) and put them in a small dish. Show your student the first number in the equation; ask her to gather that many seeds. Show your student the second number; ask her to gather that many *more* seeds. How many seeds does she have total? Have your student glue the total number of seeds in the last circle to complete the addition problem.

You may want to make story problems out of each equation (i.e. “If Maggie plants three seeds and her father plants two more, how many seeds have been planted?”).

When you are finished and the glue is dry, staple all the pages together including the covers to make a booklet.
