

Position Words

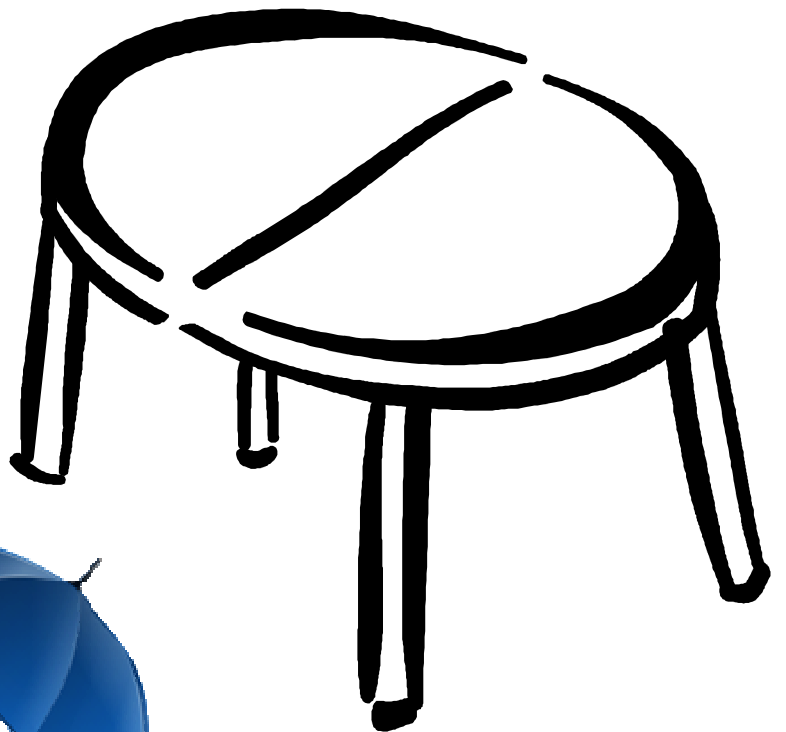
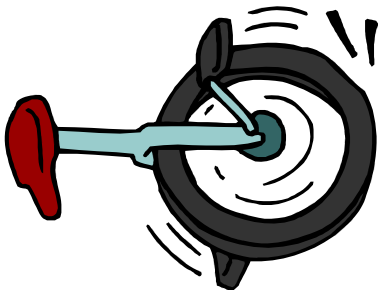
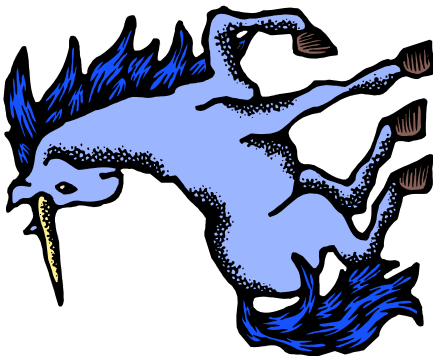
Cut out the table and glue on a 4 X 6 index card. Cut out umbrella, unicorn, unicycle and words—mount on cardboard for sturdiness or laminate. Have child demonstrate the position words using the objects. Example? "The umbrella is upon the table". Store in pocket on page two. Although "upside-down" is not a preposition, for preschoolers it could still be used.
