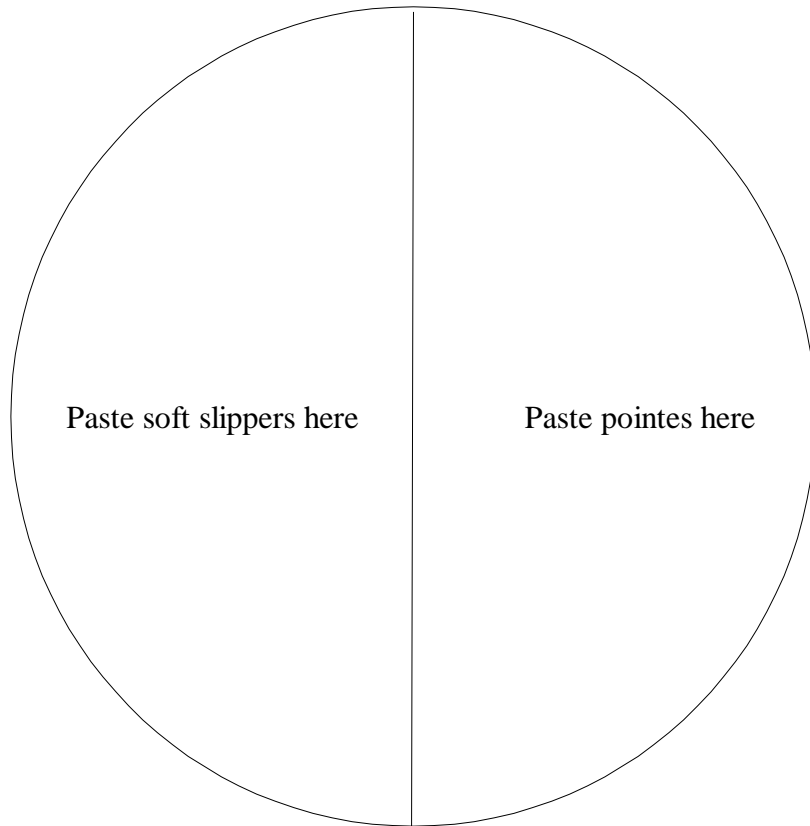


Ballet shoes




Instructions:

Print Page 1, and fold in half on the dotted line. Cut out the circles on the pages below.

Fold the circles 2 and 3 in half horizontally, with pictures and writing to the inside. Paste the half circles onto the back of circle one, The line where the two half circles join being the vertical diameter of the circle 1. Make sure that the circles are placed on the right side - kid's slipper on the corresponding side of cover etc. Trim the circle if necessary to remove excess pieces. Paste the back half of circles 2 and 3 onto the first page to complete the booklet.




Circle 1



Children's ballet slippers have soft points. The slippers are made of leather, and they are kept on the feet with ribbons and elastic. Male dancers also wear soft ballet slippers.

Circle 2



Pointes are the ballet slippers worn by adult female dancers. The toes are built up with wood and different padding materials, so that the dancer can stand on her toes, and her toes are supported. The slippers are made of leather, and are secured with ribbons and elastic.

Circle 3
