



Print the above two pages on cardstock. Especially page 2 should be on firm cardstock. Fold the stage in half, along the dotted line between the brown and the green blocks, with the color to the inside. Open out again. With a craft knife, cut the 4 vertical lines only at No 1 and 2 and 3. Cut the horizontal lines at 4.

Cut out the curtain as 1 piece, including the tabs, the ballerina with the blocks she is standing on as one piece, and the castle as one piece.

Fold the card in half again. Fold the loose tabs at 1, 2 and 3 up and then down, open the card, and then push through to the inside of the card. Paste the castle onto block 3, with the floor of the castle just above the fold line. Only put glue on the box tab, on the brown shaded bit. Paste the curtains onto the brown shaded bits of box tabs 1 and 2. Fold the tabs towards the back. And the small bit to the back again. Glue only this little piece to the back of the card. Allow the glue to dry.

Fold the tab of the ballerina along each fold line, each time toward the back. These must form a box. Carefully place the tab through the front slit at no 4, with the tab going to the bottom. Then bring the tab out to the top in the back slit at 4. Glue the last tab to the top tab - behind the ballerinas feet - to form a box. Allow to dry.

When all is dry, open and close the card a few times, to ensure that it opens to the right places. The ballerina can be moved along the stage using the long tab.

Paste the card into the stage page, ensuring that no glue comes close to any of the tab openings, or the long tab for moving the ballerina.
