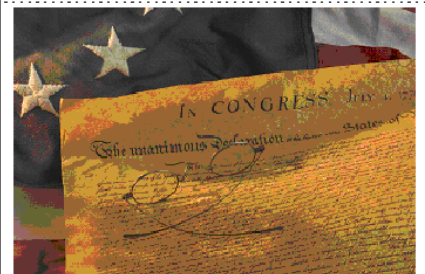


## Citizenship: Rights, Privileges, Protection
