

Rain Barrel, Plum, and Sunflower Booklets:

Rain Barrel:

Cut on solid lines, this is a 2 flap booklet. The cover (rain barrel image) will fold over the lyric flap, and on inside of final flap (which is glued down to lapbook), have student write down why folks collected rain water and what possible uses they would have for it (water animals, water for family, plants, washing, etc.)

For Sunflower Poem/Art:

Have student write a poem about sunflowers on the page, cut out and place into Sunflower booklet. The noted coloring page is perfect for this as well—all though you will need to cut/shrink to fit in the pocket. Can also use the sunflower notebook page (Latin name: Helianthus Annuus. State flower for Kansas. Uses: live stock feed, cooking oil/eating seeds, bird food, skin care products, industrial products, in gardens).
