

Cut out the three circles. Fold each one in half.

Glue the back of the left half of the first circle to the front of the left half of the second circle.

Take the third circle. Glue the back of the left half of the third circle to the back of the right half of the first circle. Fold so that you can open the book once to the right and once to the left. So, the "middle section" is actually the front of your book.

Compare and contrast the qualities a person possesses by focusing on the character trait you are studying (left hand side of the assembled book) and qualities that would be opposite to that (right hand side of the book). Example: If the character trait being studied is Joy then on the left hand side you might have the word "smiles" and the right hand side "frowns", etc.
