

1. Powerful dark brown wings
2. White tail feathers
3. Yellow feet
4. Sharp talons
5. White feathers on head
6. Keen eyes (to spot prey)
7. Sharp yellow bill (to eat prey)



# Eagle Anatomy



What you see on the previous page is the inside of your book. Cut out as one piece and fold in half. Have your student color the eagle (brown body, brown wings, white head, white tail feathers, etc.).

Let your student write the number next to each part of the eagle or just use the book for discussion. (i.e. "Can you show me the talons?"). A very young student could even draw a line to match the body part to the correct text.
