

**PRINT ON CARDSTOCK.**  
Cut each piece out on the solid black lines. Attach with brass fastener where indicated.

Its tube like body is made of tiny segments.

- Each is filled with liquid and covered with bristles.

A worm has no skeleton, eyes, lungs, or ears.



The front of a worm is more pointed than the back.



A worm's body is damp, but not slimy.



A worm breathes through its skin by taking in air that is trapped in the soil.
