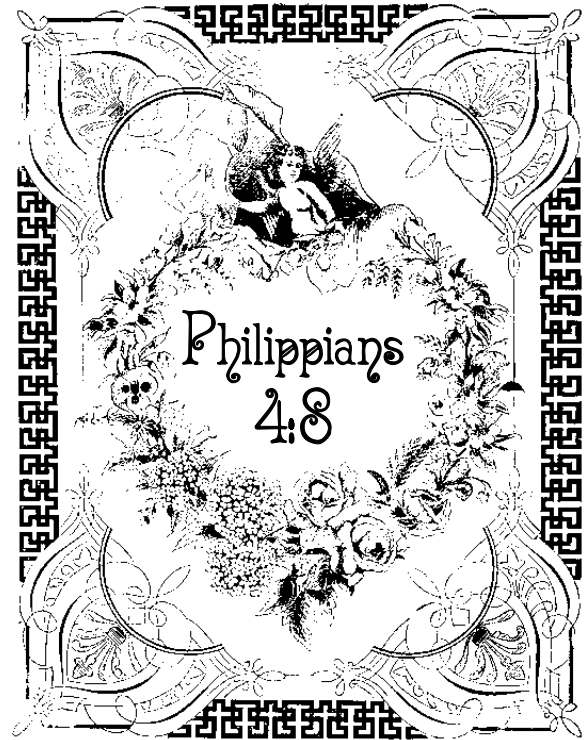


Print all pages on paper. Cut on solid lines. Mountain fold all pages on the dotted lines.
