The regular rise and fall of the ocean level are called tides. The Moon sets tides in motion. As the Moon (M) passes around the water covered Earth (E), the gravity of the moon tries to pull the earth towards it. While the solid parts of Earth move as a whole, the water obeys the slightest impulse and moves towards the Moon where her attraction is the strongest. Consequently, the waters directly under the moon (a) are perpetually elevated, and those at (c) and (d) are lowered. So, when the Moon is over the center of an ocean, it pulls the water away from the continent, causing a low tide. When the moon is over the edge of the continent, it pulls the water towards the edge, causing high tide. The highest tides, called flood tides, occur when the Moon is full. The lowest tides, called ebb tides, occur when the Moon is new. As the Earth turns on her axis every 24 hours, every place on earth will experience a high tide, and a low tide, once in 24 hours.
