Complete the saliva lesson in your FIAR Volume IV manual. Let your student color the tongue. Cut on the solid black lines. Using an exacto knife, cut the black line in the mouth. Carefully put glue on the outer edges of the back of the mouth rectangle. Use it sparingly at the top making sure you only have a thin strip. Once the glue is dry, Bend the tongue and insert it into the mouth. Pull in and out to review what saliva is and what it does.
