a Japanese form of wrestling that combines techniques from many jujutsu schools

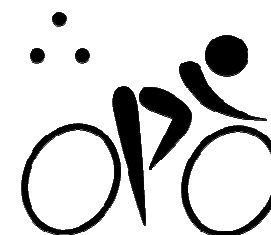
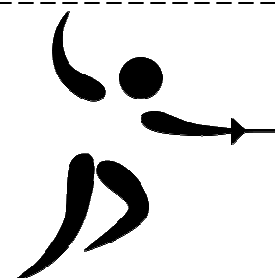
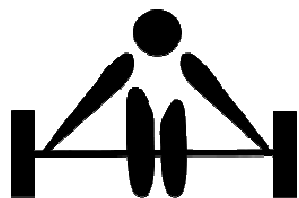
a field game played by two teams of ten players each who use a long-handled stick with a net pouch on one end to carry or throw a ball into a goal
