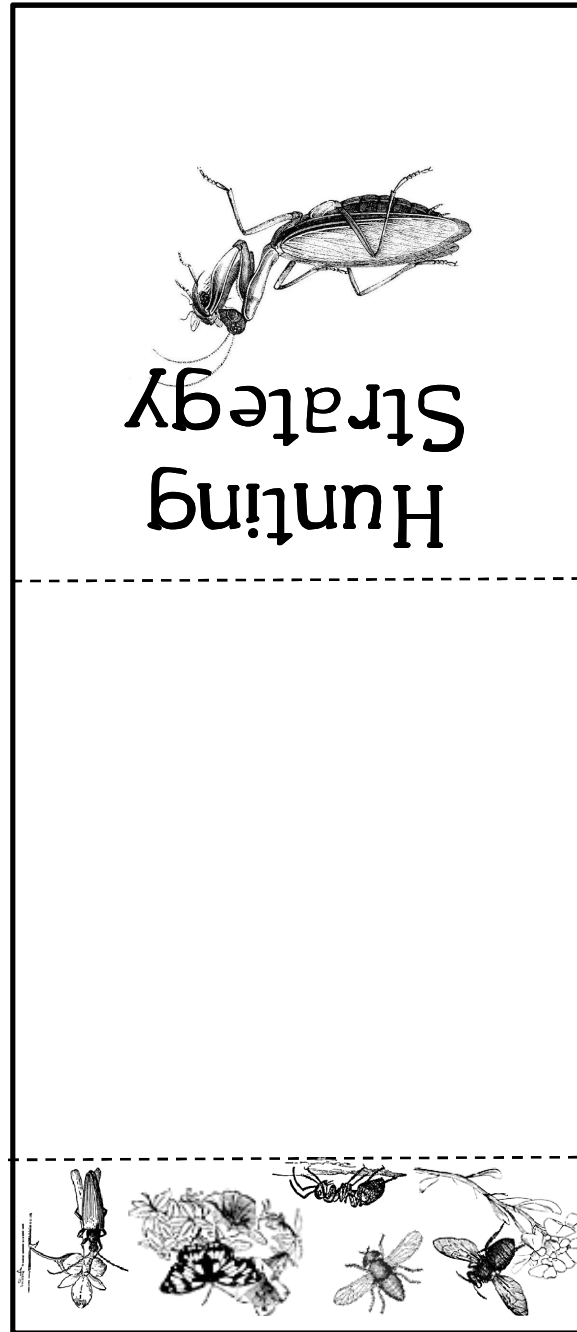


Cut both pieces out at the solid lines. Fold longer piece at dotted lines (matchbook style). Glue shorter piece to the inside of the longer piece.

Answer Key

A praying mantis likes to **AMBUSH** its prey, not stalk it. Once an insect or other tasty animal is **CLOSE** enough, the mantis will grab it with its spiny front **LEGS** and bite the back of its **NECK** to kill it. A mantis will only eat **LIVE** prey. After it finishes eating, the mantis will **GROOM** itself like a **CAT**. First, it cleans its **FRONT** legs. Then, it uses them to clean every part of its **HEAD**.
