


Cut the envelope (on previous page) out as one piece. Cut the slit (dotted lines) with an exacto knife). Fold sides in. Fold bottom up and fold top down and tuck in to flap. Open envelope.

Cut out each piece on this page. Stack together with cover on top. Staple. Paste back of last piece to the inside of your envelope. Close envelope.
