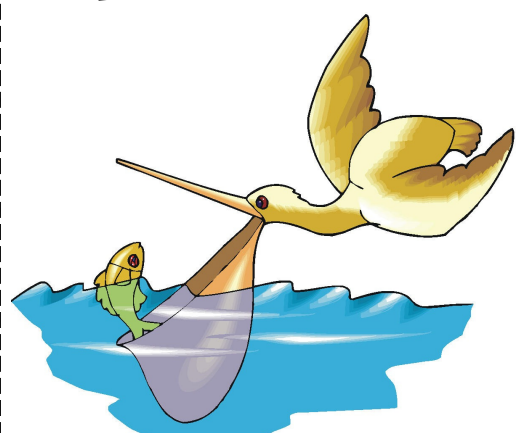


Name of Seabird	Method Used

<p>This bird is a surface feeder. It paddles around in a circle and makes the water swirl. This brings bits of food to the surface.</p>	<p>This bird scavenges food from fisherman, other birds, and even garbage dumps.</p>	<p>This bird plunge dives to capture food. It soars high above the water until it spies a fish; it dives straight down, opens its beak, and scoops the fish up.</p>	<p>This bird is smart! It drops rocks on clams to shatter the shell. Then it swoops down to claim the meat.</p>	<p>This bird steals food from puffins.</p>	<p>This bird dives deep from the water's surface and swims underwater to chase and catch a meal.</p>
