

Print all pages on paper. Cut on solid lines. Fold all pages on the dotted lines. Stack pages with cover page on bottom (so that it becomes the cover when stapled). The poem should be the 1<sup>st</sup> page of book. Staple through cover, being sure to catch all pages.

(Have child copy one line of poem per inside page.)

## THE SLOTH

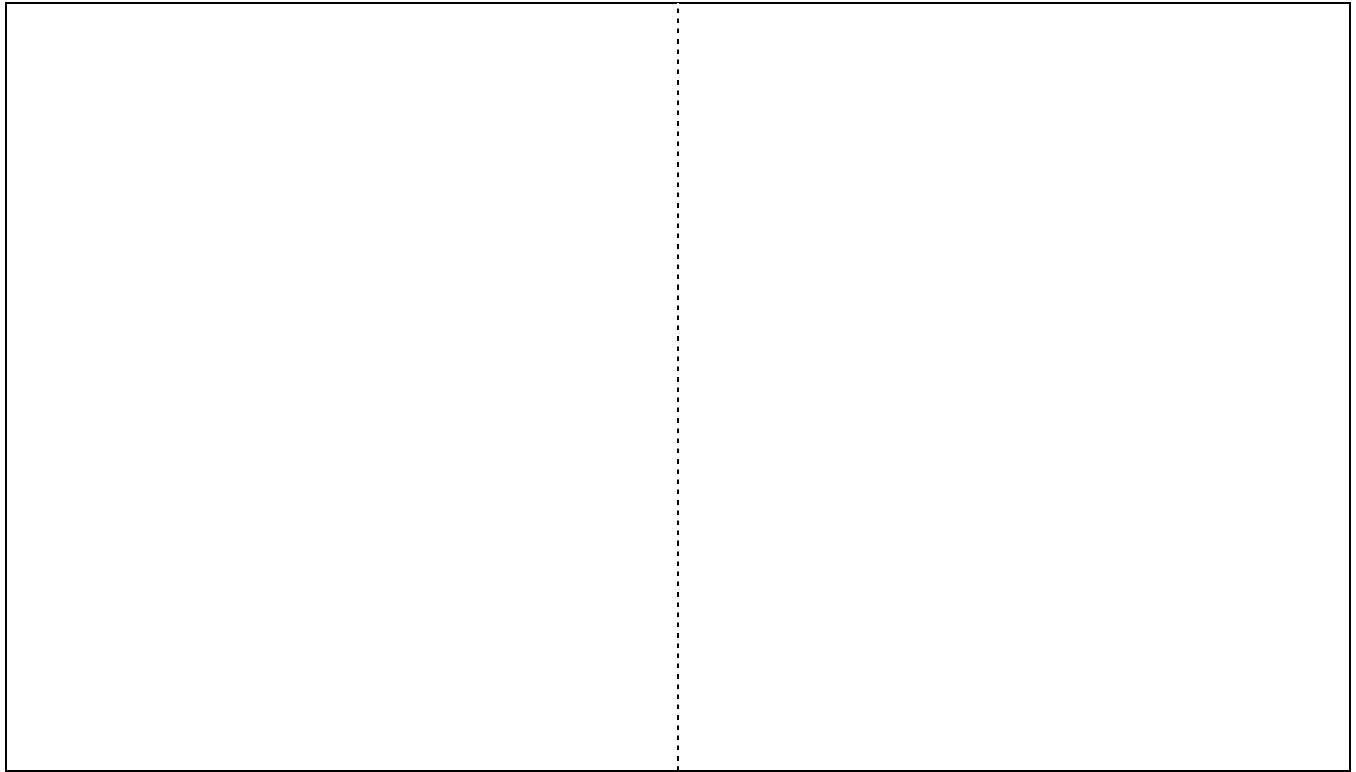
