



Cut out trading cards on solid lines.

Child can draw the phase of the moon. Store in pocket.

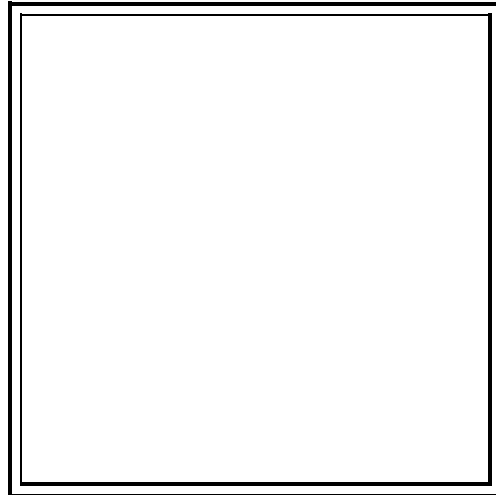

Full Moon

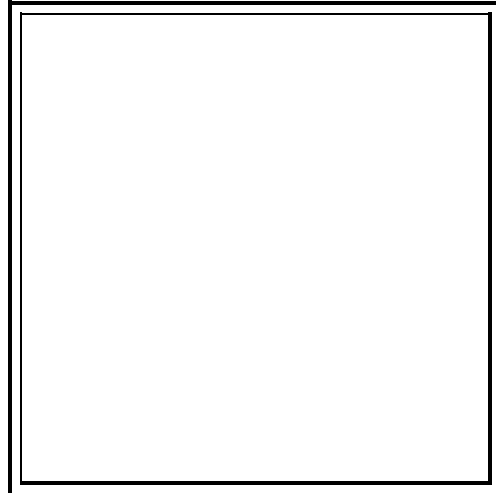
The side of the moon facing us is completely visible!



Phase: Full Moon

Waning Gibbous

The moon looks like the letter "C"; it looks like it is shrinking.

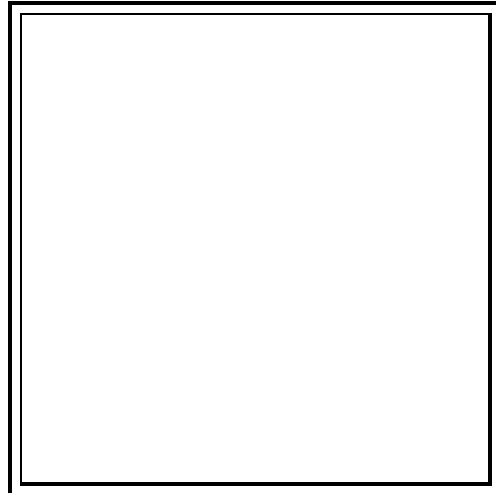


Phase: Waning Gibbous

First Quarter Moon

The right side of the moon is visible.

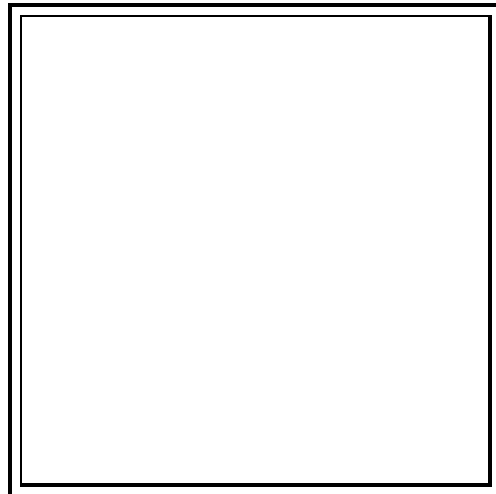
(*Remember, there is half of the moon – the other side – that we can't see. So, a Quarter Moon looks like a Half Moon to us!)

Waxing Gibbous

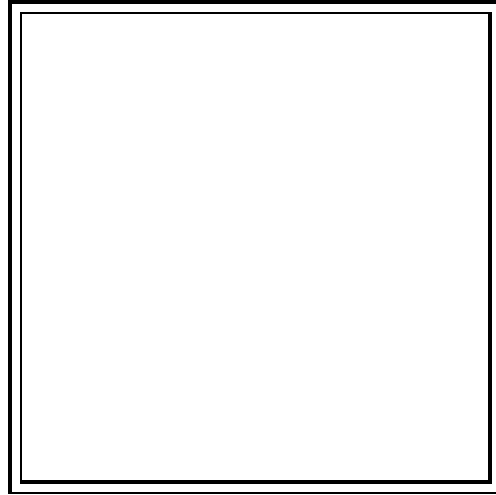
The moon is appears to be almost full!



Phase: Waxing Gibbous

New Moon

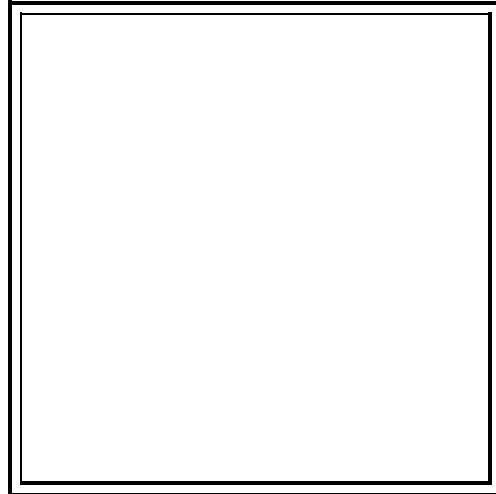
The Moon is between the sun and the earth so it is dark (invisible) to us.



Phase: New Moon

Waxing Crescent

A banana shaped portion of the moon can be seen.
