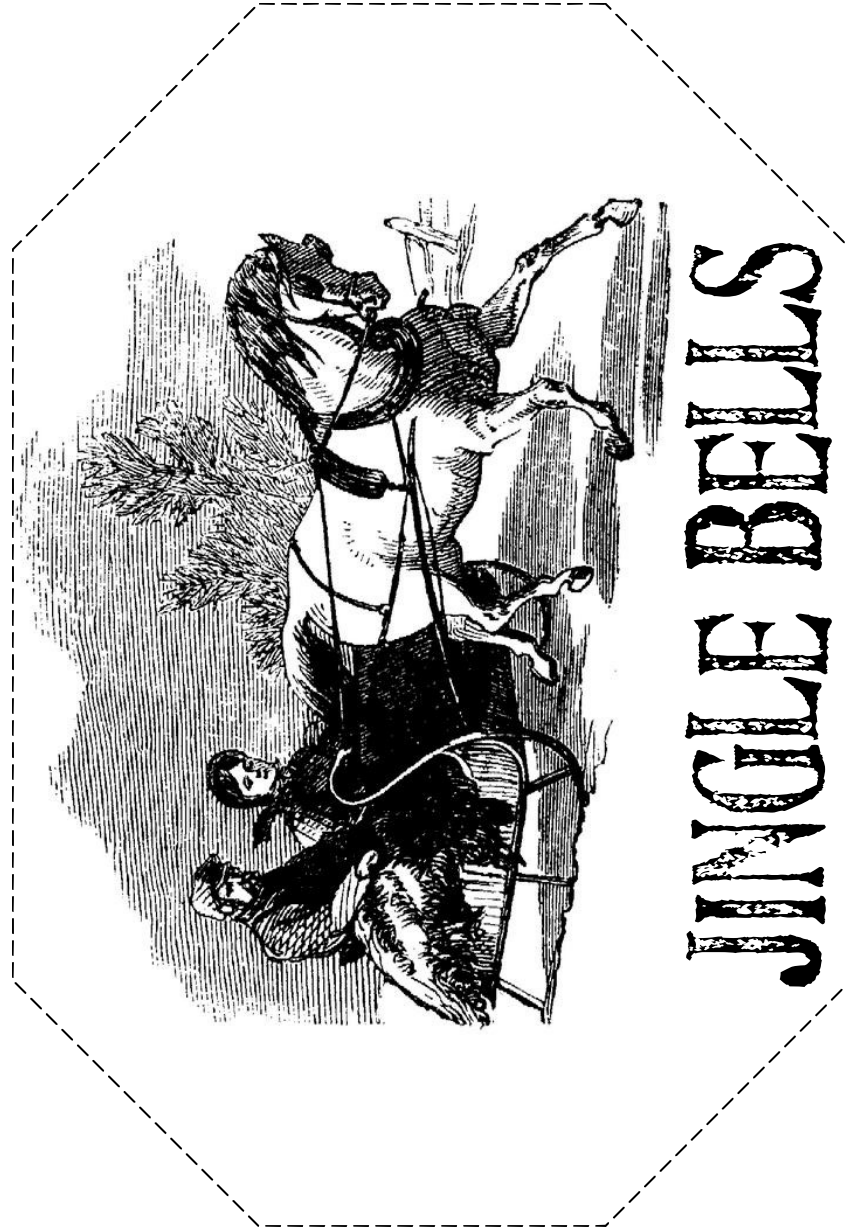


Cut out the books on pages 2 and 3 as one piece. Fold in half. Let your student complete the copywork.
