

Shapes Train Scene

Print the second page on white cardstock. Identify the different shapes with child—circles, rectangles, square, octagon, and triangles. Have child cut out the shapes and either paint or color them. The shapes can then be glued together to make a train and a stop sign. This could be used to glue to the front of the lapbook for the cover décor or glued to the back of the lapbook. You could brainstorm with your child other things that could be added to the scene and what shape would be needed to make it. For example, a sun—circle, tracks—rectangles, house—square or rectangle, ... Clear contact paper could be added for durability.
