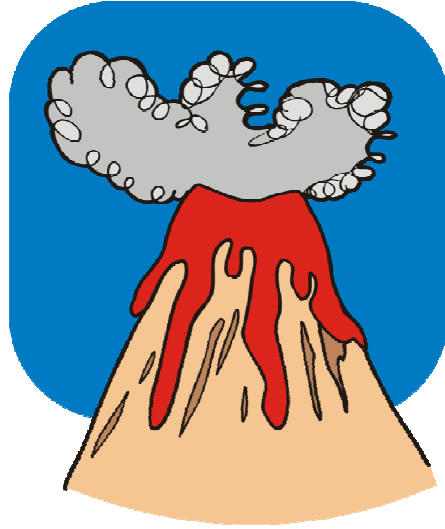


What's the Difference?



REMOVE THIS AREA (Cut away so you have just a tab left)

Made up of many layers of lava. It's very fluid when it flows out of the volcano.

REMOVE THIS AREA

Has many layers of broken rock and ash.

Assembly Directions:

Cut the six strips along the solid outer lines. If there is a rectangle piece in the right corner of the strip, cut it off as indicated (remove this area). Stack your strips in order with cover on top and staple where indicated.

Have student write the appropriate word in the tab area of book. Answers are Composite (or Stratovolcano), Shield, Cinder Cone, Lava Dome. Use right side of each page for student to draw picture of each type of volcano.
