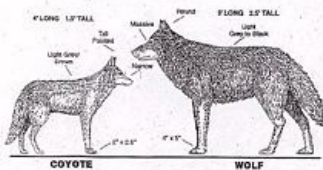


Recognizing A Gray Wolf

- 2.5 feet tall
- 5-6 feet long
- 80-100 pounds
- Broad snout
- Round ears
- Color varies from black to white
- Long, low howl



Wolves are protected by federal law under the Endangered Species Act.



The U.S. Forest Service and U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service request that hunters report any sightings or wolf sign. Please make these reports to the MT FishWildlife & Parks, local Forest Service office, or the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service at (406) 449-5225.

Information provided by hunters will aid in the management and eventual removal of wolves from the endangered species list.
