

On The Run -

Wolves will travel for long distances by trotting at about five miles per hour. When chasing prey, the wolf can achieve estimated speeds of between 28 and 40 miles per hour for up to 20 minutes. Wolves may travel 10 to 30 miles each day in search of food. Wolves that are leaving their packs in search of a mate have been known to travel distances of 550 miles away from their home territory.
