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Color cards, if desired. Cut apart and store in pockets.


Ideas for the cards


1. Matching Game (match animal to its gift suggestion/animal to product)


2. Story Sequencing (Put cards in order of the story)

3. Put animal cards face down in a "pond" and let student choose one. When he turns it over, act out the animal.

4. Hide the cards from your student and play a memory game. Ask your student to recall the animals in the story. When he mentions one, let him "win" the card. You can do the same kind of game with the animal products.







Cut out "Animal Sounds" book as one piece and fold in half.


Assemble matchbooks on next page. Cut on solid lines and fold on dotted. Cut out animals.


Help your student decide which animal should go into each book.








Use this piece with the minibook on the next page.


Cut out book as one piece. Fold in half. Cut out picture of bear on the previous page. Let your student color and paste into book.




Cut file folder out as one piece. Fold in half (horizontally). Cut out pictures and let your student paste in the appropriate spots.
