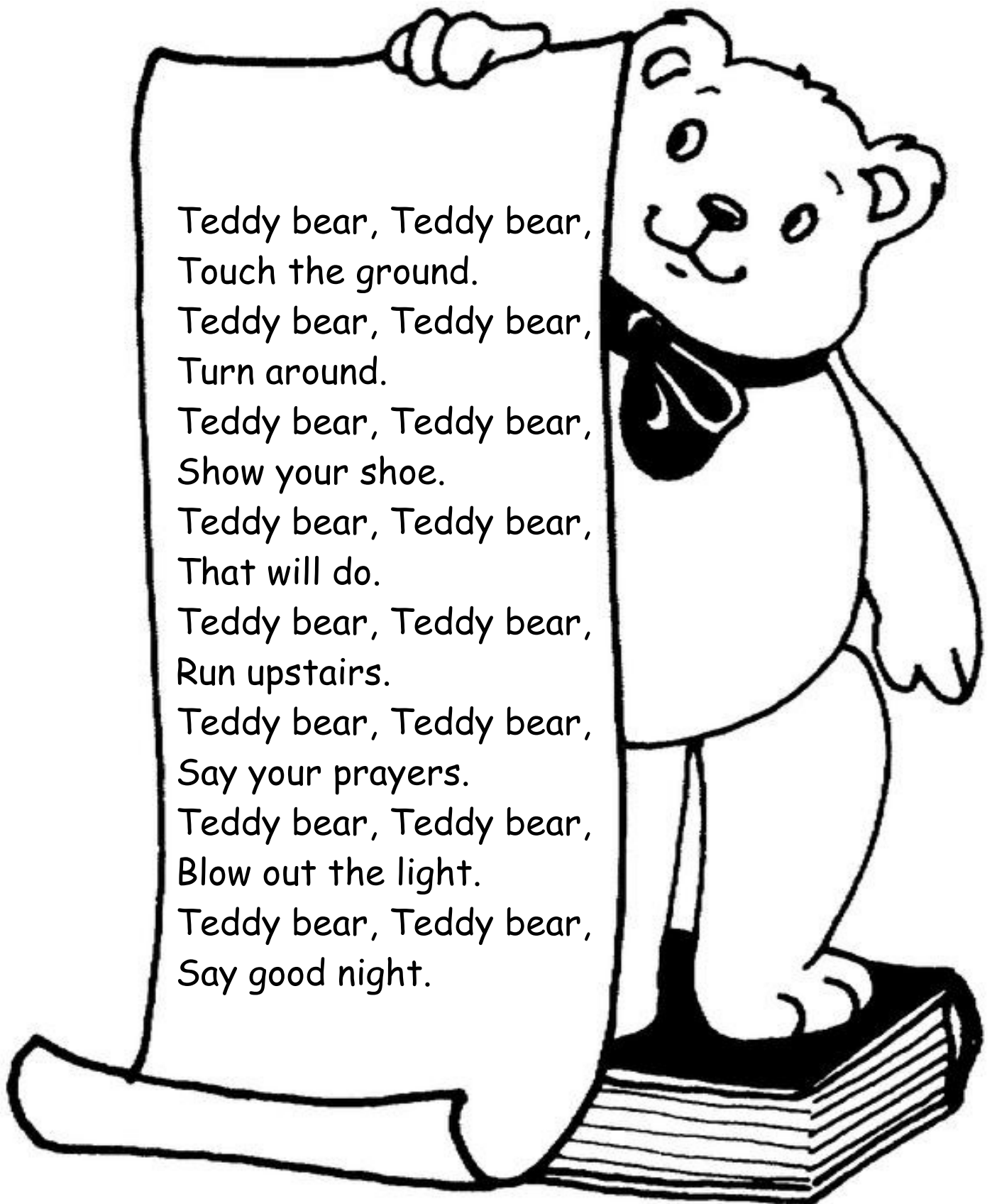


corduroy

Cut each page out. Let your student color the pictures, if desired. Encourage her to trace the words. Let your student find and glue the appropriate picture on each page (some are interchangeable). This book should probably take more than one day for a small child to complete. You don't want her to grow weary of coloring or tracing the words. You may want to do a few pages each day throughout your week with Corduroy.

Take four sheets of paper (preferably colored) and fold each one in half (horizontally like a hamburger). Glue (rubber cement and double-stick tape work well) the back of one piece to the front of the next. Continue with all four sheets. When you are finished, you should have an eight page booklet.

You may want to take a picture of this special toy to include on the answer page.



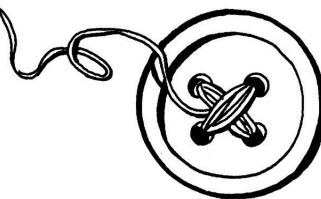
Fold paper in half on dotted line. Cut heart shape out (making sure you leave it attached on the fold at the top of the heart). Cut and paste the Bible verse inside.

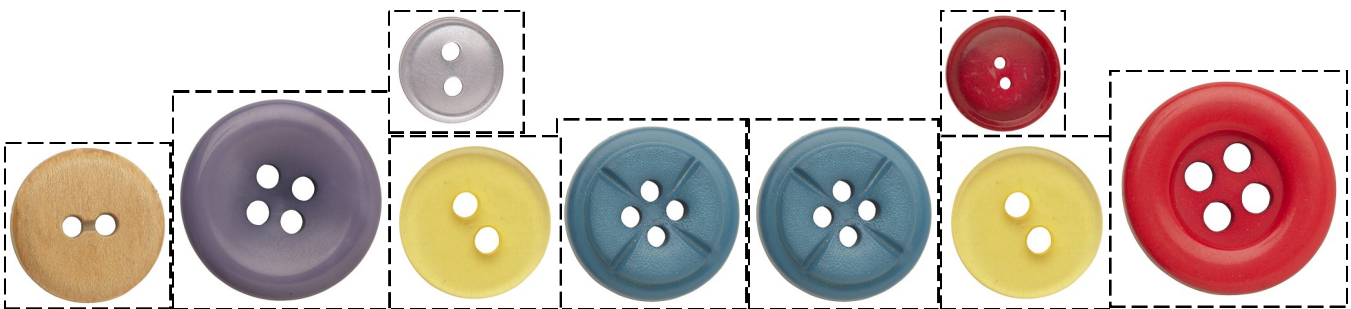
