**Animals of Costa Rica**: Picture cards are provided, but your student will need to research the rainforest animals in order to write facts on the cards.



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cities on the flaps).








Cut out all three strips. Glue together as indicated. Fold like an accordion. Paste the back of the last piece to your lapbook.


Write one product on each page of the book and paste the corresponding picture to that page.






On the front of each matchbook, draw a picture that reminds you of Costa Rica. Cut on solid black lines. Fold books matchbook style.

## Flag of COSTA RICA


**Directions:** Cut out book out as one piece. Fold in half. Cut out flag. Color. Paste inside book. Older students may want to write a few flag facts in the book as well.




