



The dog breed mini-books require additional research.


Grip's page includes a hotdog fold book. Use these instructions to complete it.







Print on cardstock. Cut out each page. Write German Shepherd facts on each one. Stack together with cover on top and secure with a brad.



Cut book out as one piece. Fold matchbook style.










Cut book out as one piece. Fold flaps down. Write about the old master under the first flap and write about the new master under the second.






Cut out as one piece and fold in half. Write a memorial to or epitaph for Wolf on the inside of this book.


SAVING THE PUPS
