

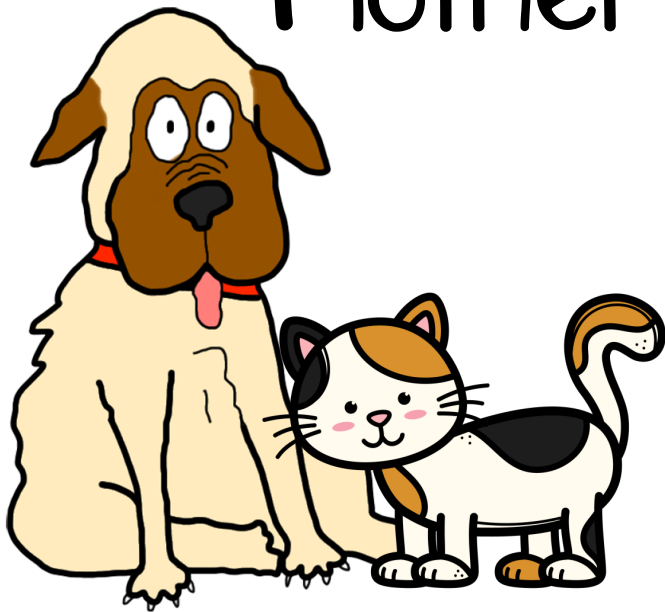

Directions: Cut book out as one piece and fold in half. Write chapter summary inside.

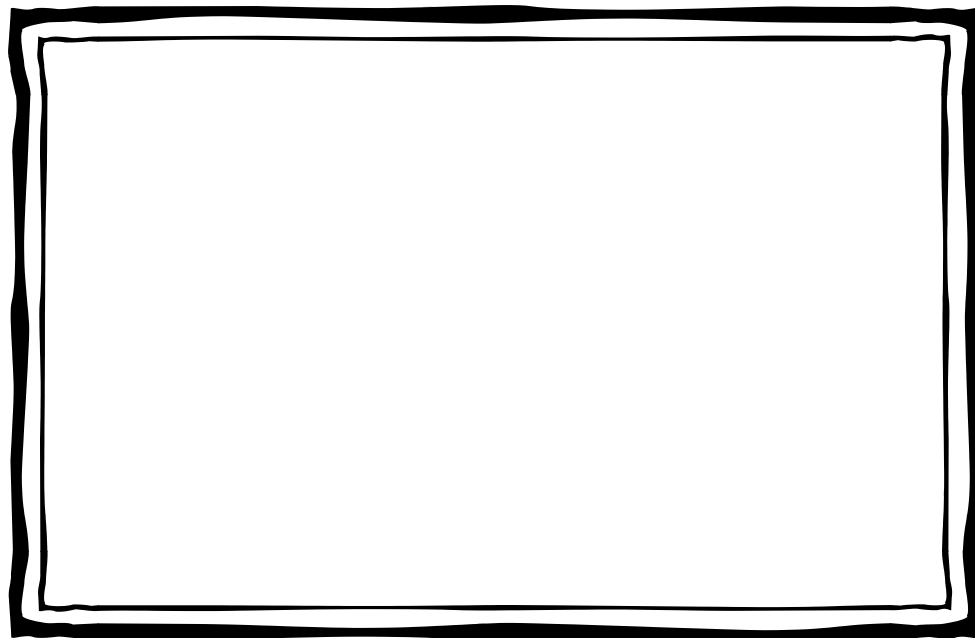

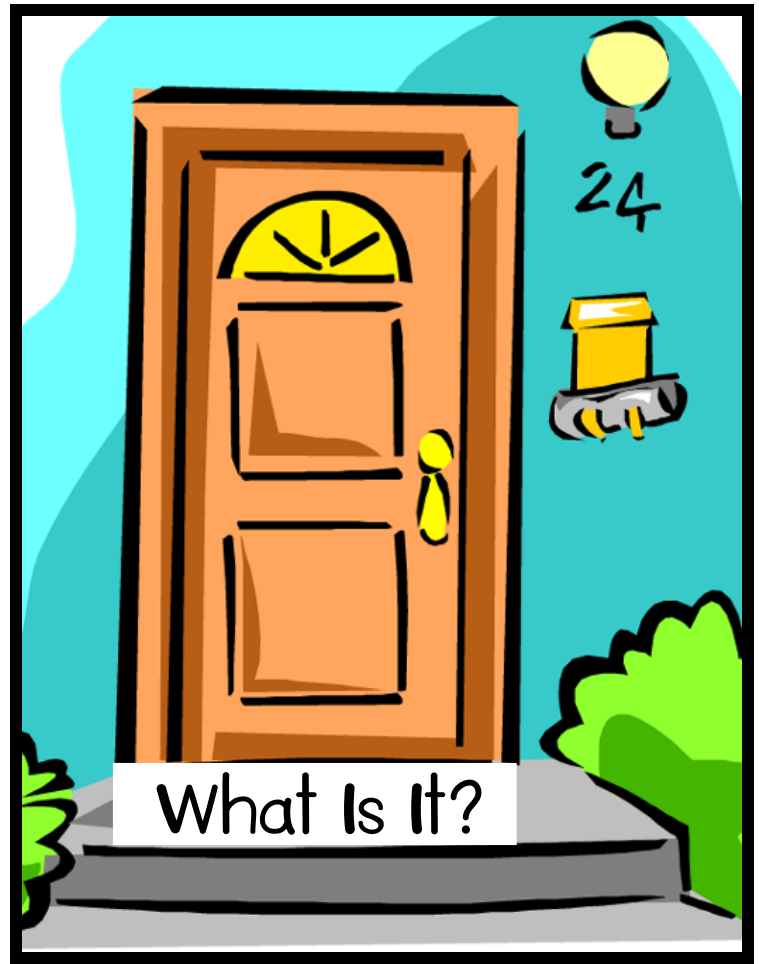
Chapter Summary

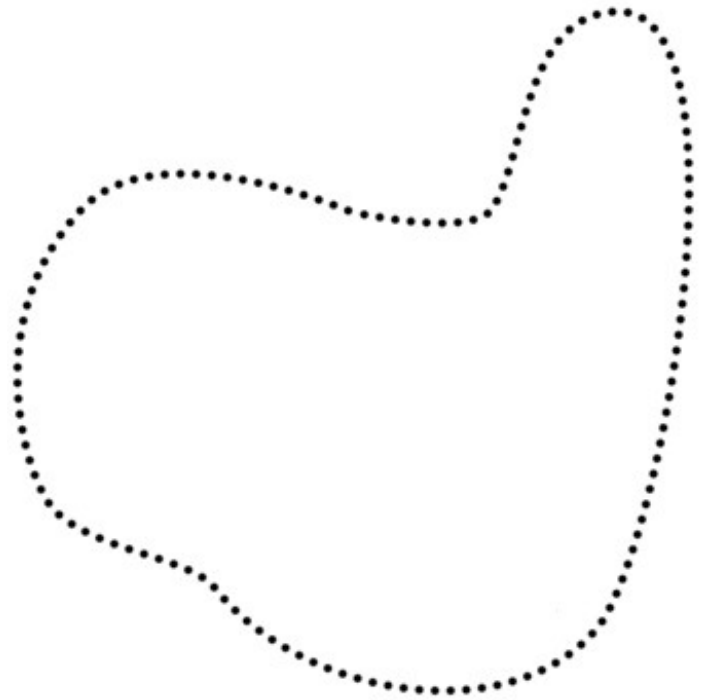
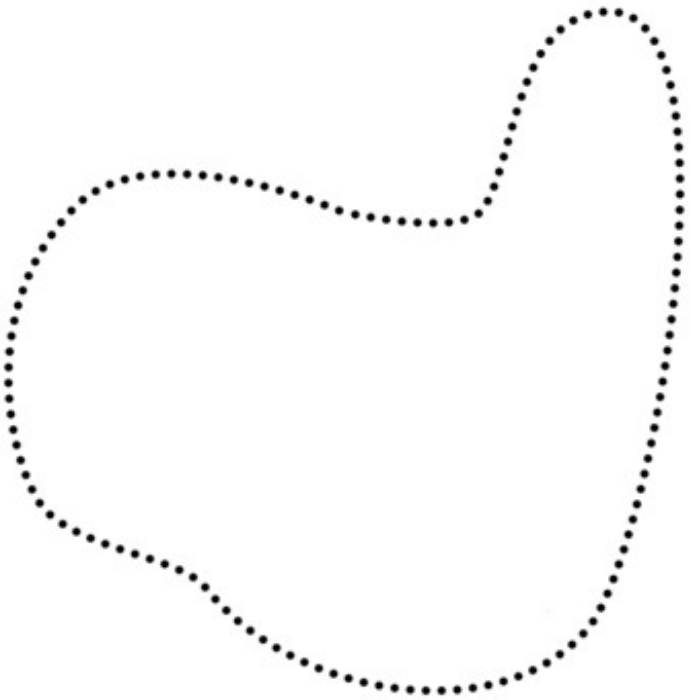
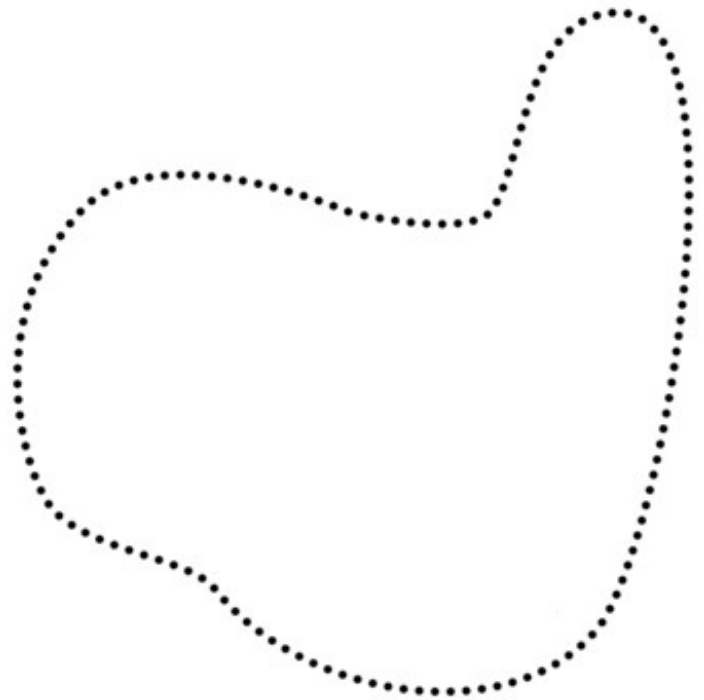
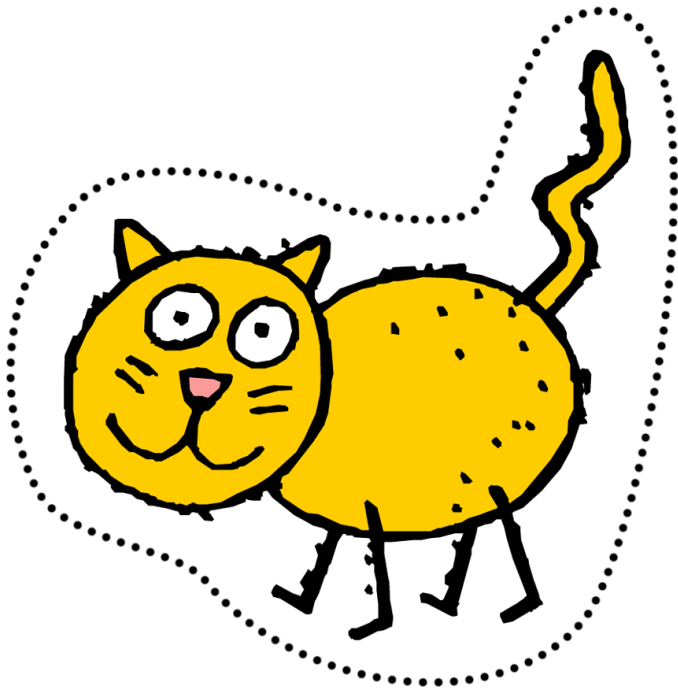
Directions: Cut out both pieces.

Using a razor blade, cut three slits around the top, bottom, and right side of the door.

Let your student write a chapter summary on the white box as indicated. You may want to type/print and cut/paste the summary to the box since it isn't very large.

Glue colored rectangle on top of white rectangle with summary. Your student should be able to open the door to read the summary.

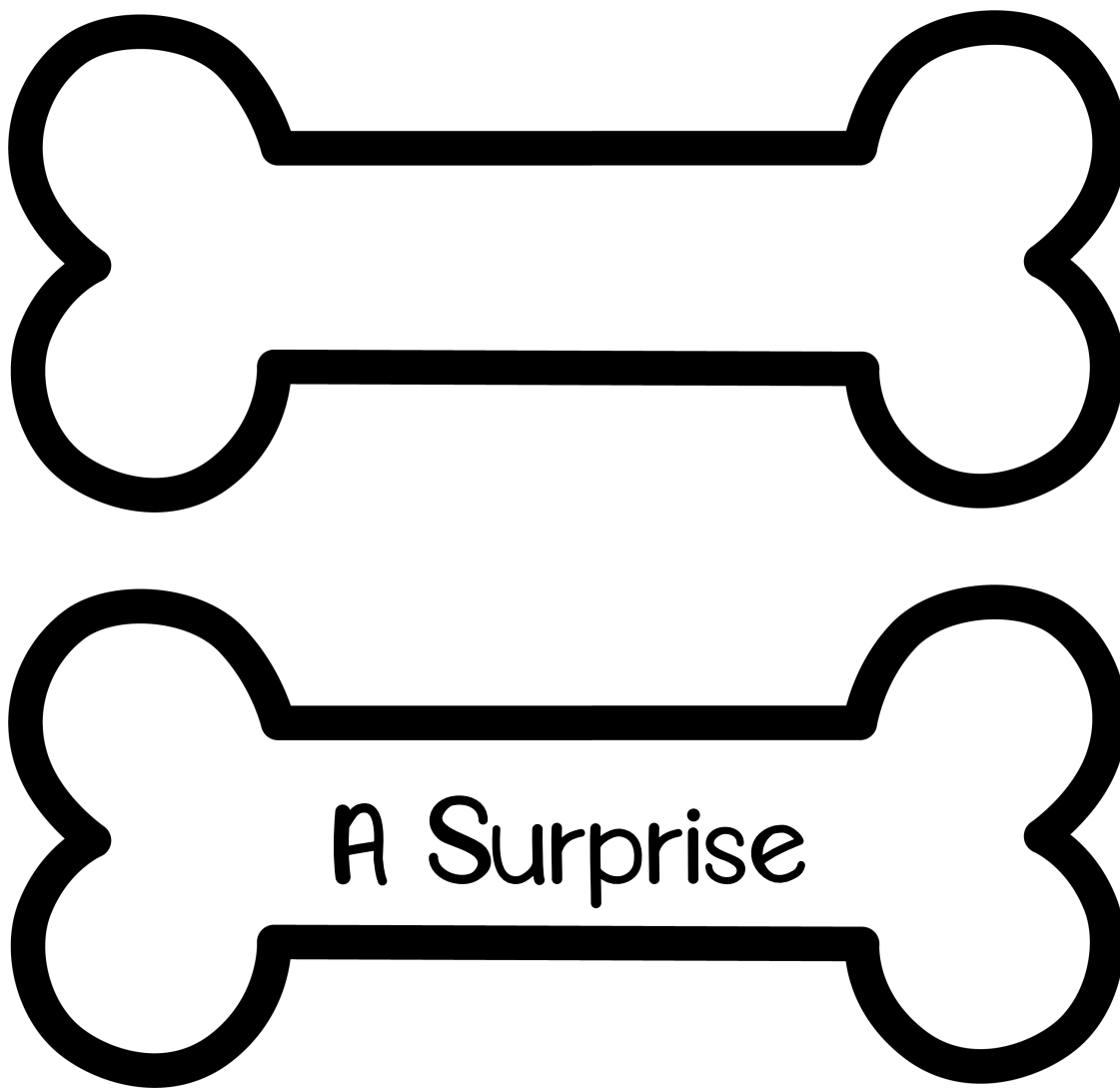


Cat Shape Book

Directions: Cut out cat shapes. Let your student use each piece to write something he knows (personality traits) about the cat in the story. Stack together and secure with staple or brass fastener.

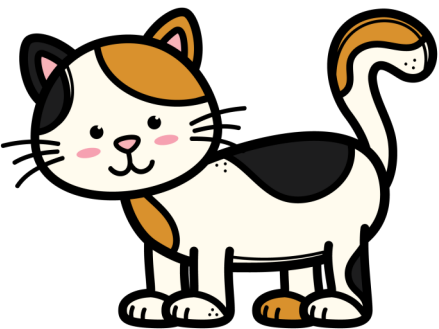
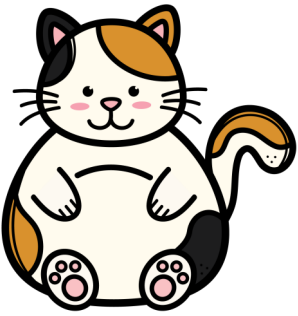
A Surprise Chapter Summary

Directions: Cut out bone shapes. Write the chapter summary on the blank shape. Stack together with cover on top and staple.

Directions: Cut shapes apart. Let your student write a word that rhymes with cat on each shape: rat, bat, pat, and fat. Stack together and secure with a brass fastener or a staple.
