Pat-a-Cake Printables

This is a simple set of printables designed for a toddler or preschooler. Have fun with the rhymes and songs! That's the best part. You can use these files as you desire in a blank board book, in a lapbook, or on cardstock in a folder.



Supplies Needed

- Cardstock
- Brown Paper
- White Puffy Paint
- White Tempera Paint
- Flour
- Baking supplies to complete activities below
- Playdough

Other Activities

- Make muffins together; read *If You Give a Moose a Muffin*
- Make gingerbread men together
- Play with playdough and cookie cutters
- Visit a bakery

- Paste pictures of your baking adventures in your lapbook or notebook
- Make scones

Pat-a-Cake Scones Recipe

1 1/2 cups self-rising flour

1/3 cup sugar

1 cup heavy whipping cream

colored sugar

Preheat oven to 375. Combine flour and sugar. Make a well in the center of the flour. Add cream. Stir till mixed well. Coat hands with flour. Knead a few times. Start singing Pat-a-Cake. (We sang it a few times!) Pat out flat. Cut into triangle or circle shapes. Sprinkle colored sugar on top. Bake 18 min. or until golden.



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
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Use this as a cover page, if desired.

Paste this label above the envelope. Store muffin matching cards in envelope.


Muffin Matching





Print muffin memory match cards on cardstock.


Directions: Use these cards to play a memory matching game. Store the cards in an envelope.




Directions: Fill in your student's first initial and name in the blanks above. Cut out page and add it to your book or lapbook.


C is for



Directions: Let your student color the cake. Paste the "C is for" and the cake on the same page.



Stir a bowl of gingerbread,

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Directions: Use this as a pattern. Trace gingerbread man on brown paper. Cut out. Mix some white tempera paint with flour to thicken it. Let your student "frost" the cookies by painting them with the thickened white paint.

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
