Type of Government: Constitutional Democracy

Leader of the Government: President

Popular Sports: Popular sports include basketball, boxing, billiards, soccer, and volleyball.

Archipelago: The Philippines is an archipelago (string of islands). It includes over 7,100 islands in southeastern Asia.

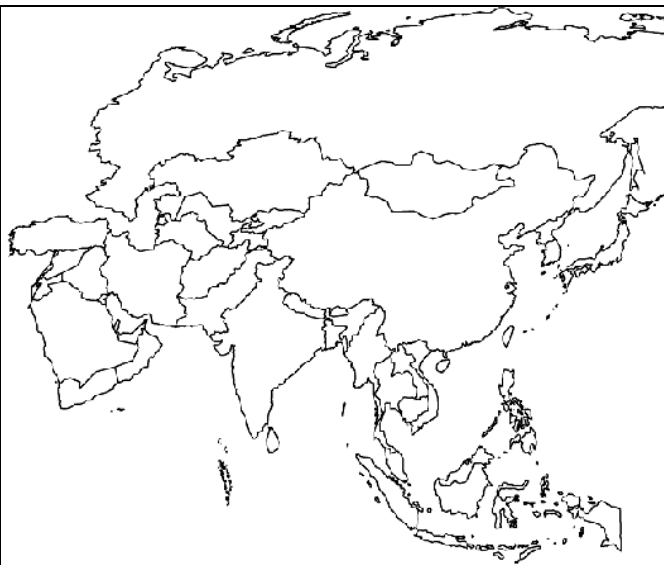








The white triangle stands for equality. The blue field symbolizes peace, truth, and justice. The red field symbolizes patriotism and courage.



Cut out flag book as one piece. Fold in half. Color flag. Paste the flag and flag information inside the book.

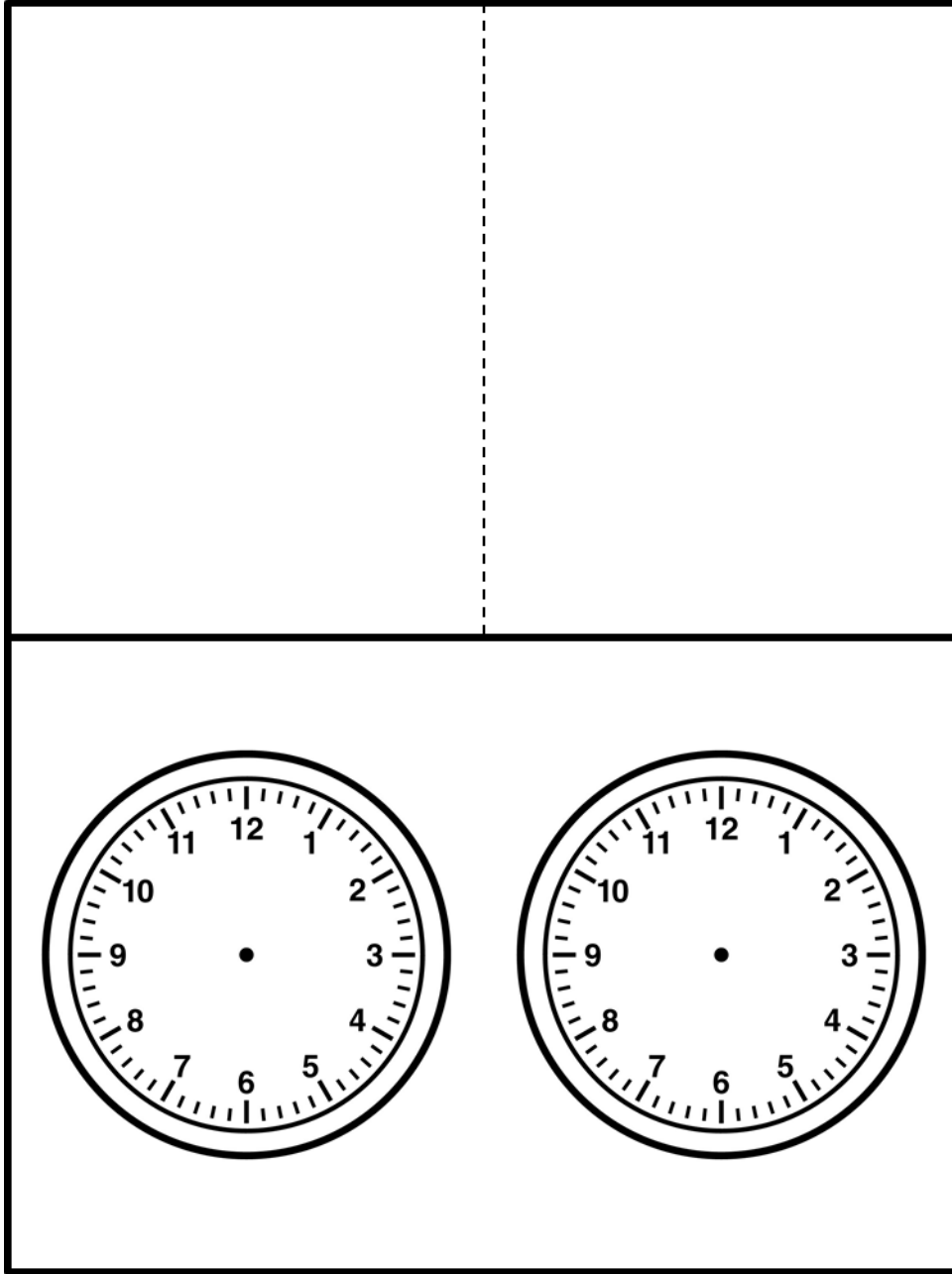
