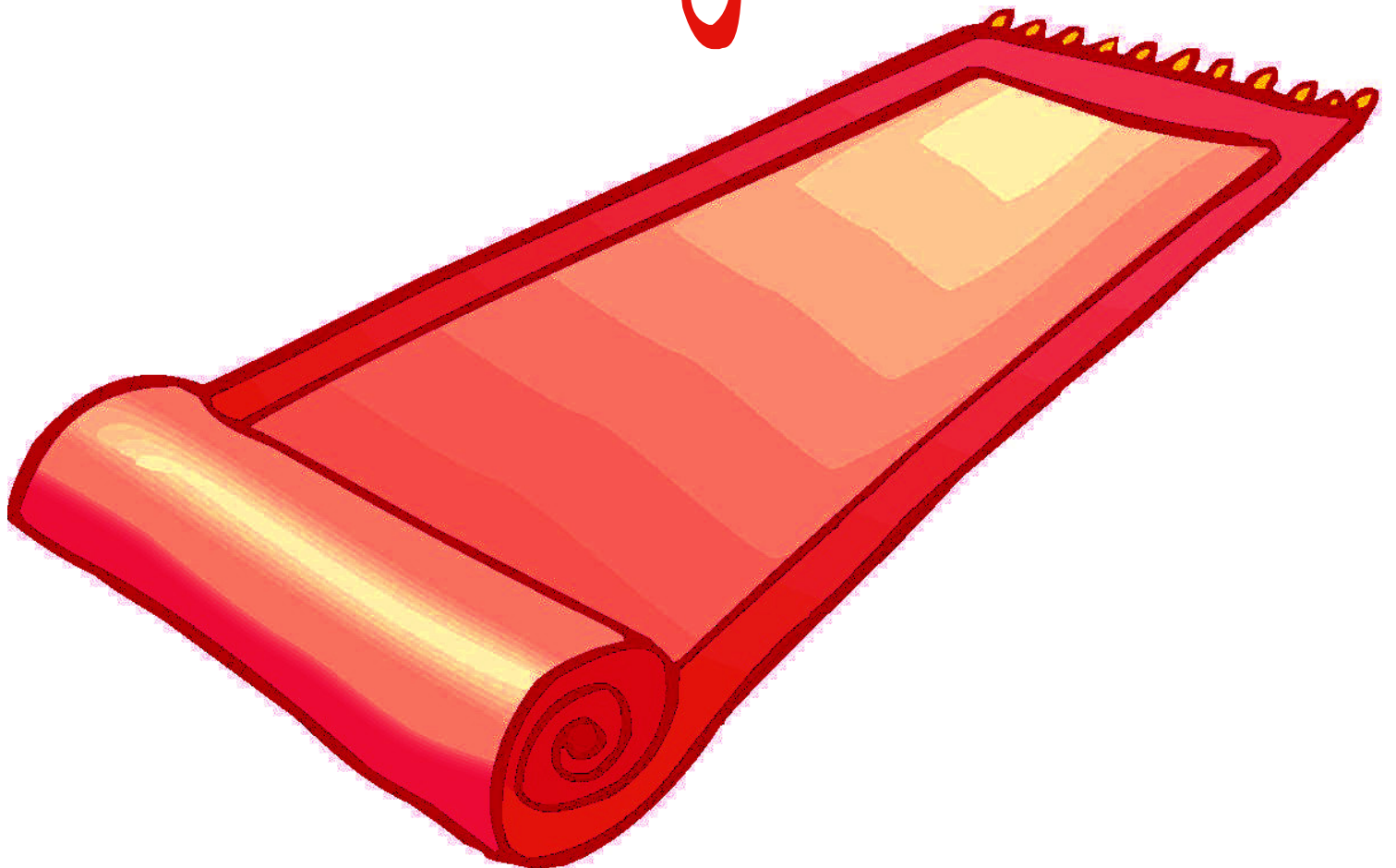
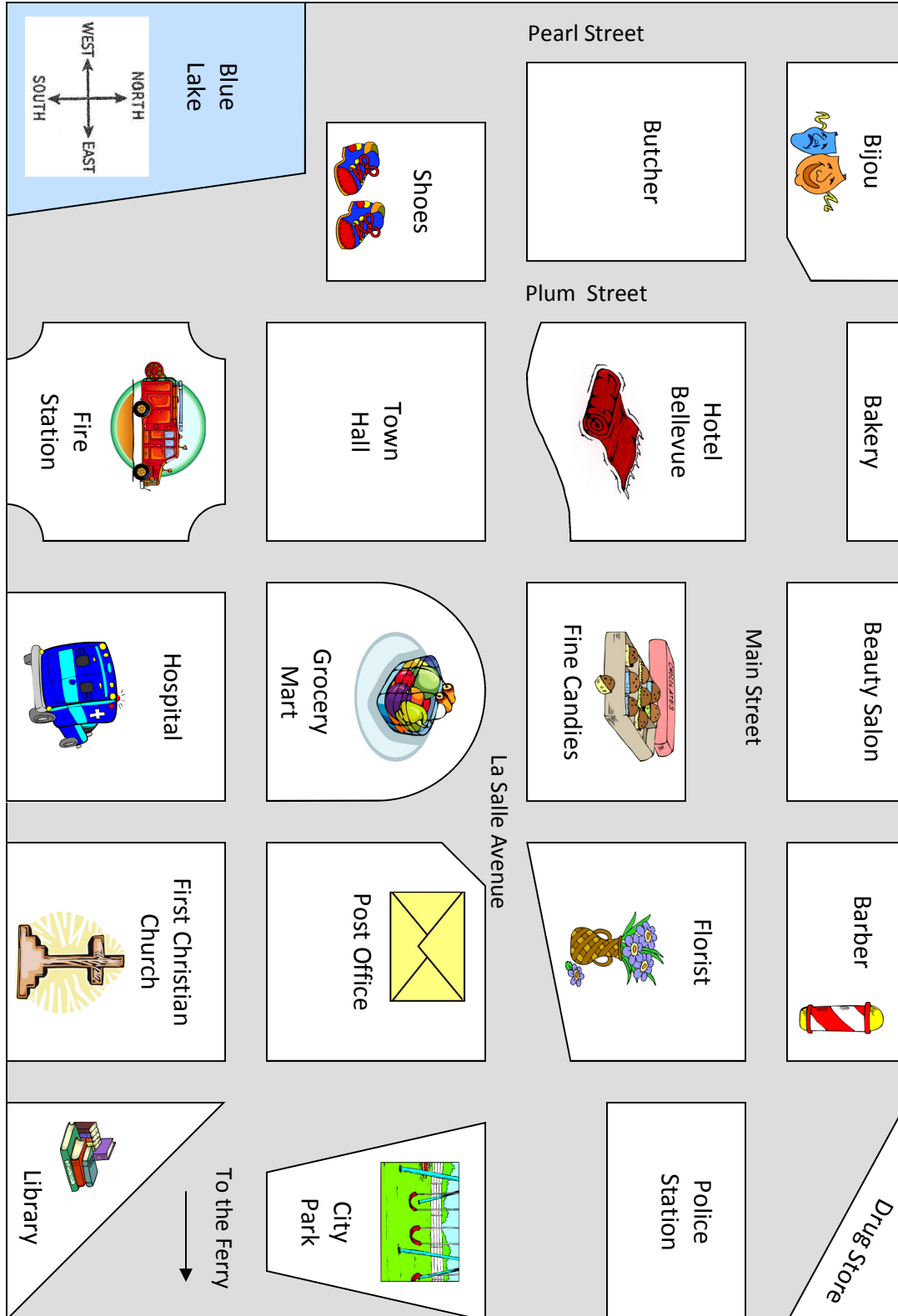


The Red Carpet



Red Carpet on the Loose!

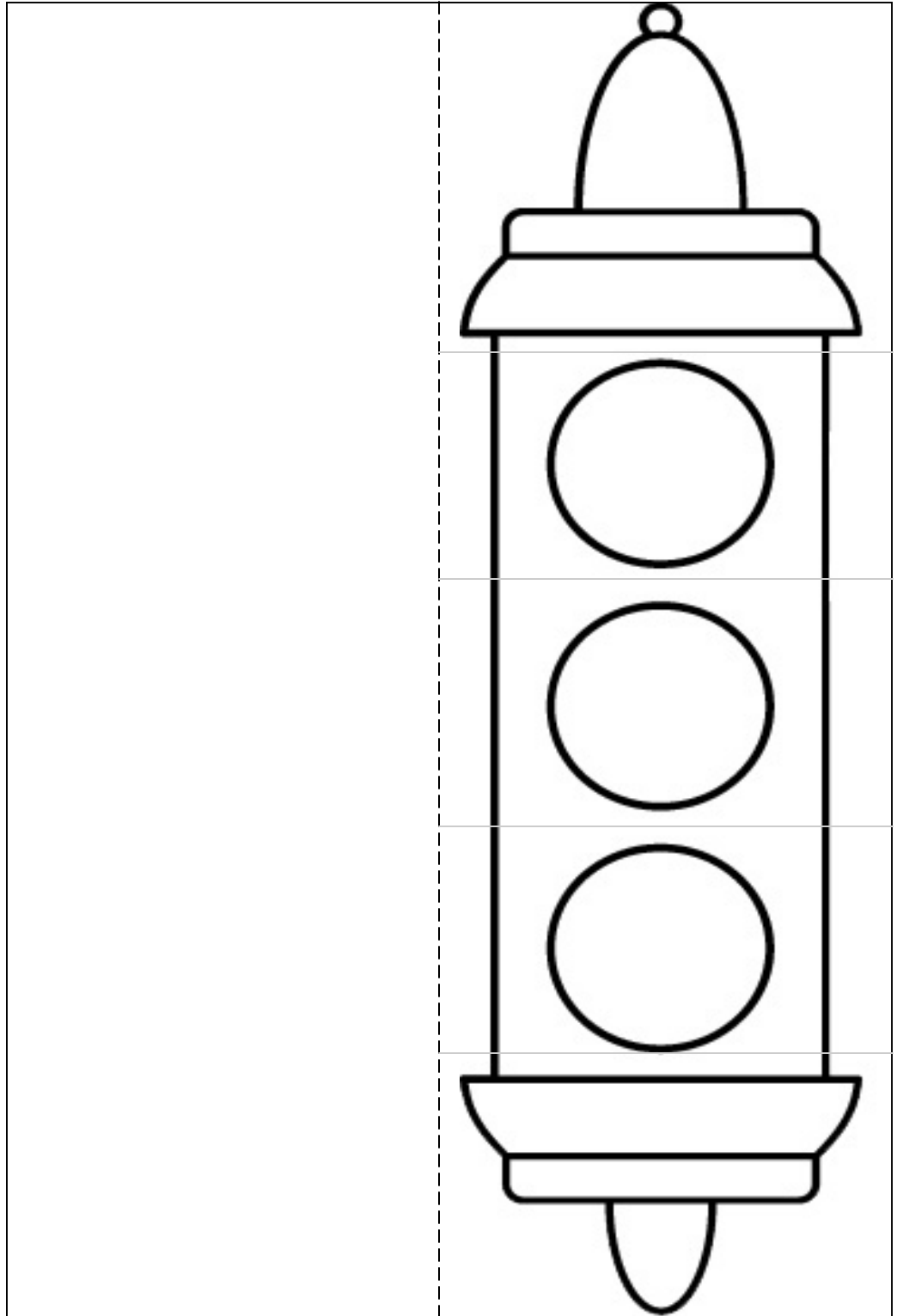
Discuss what makes a city go round. After your discussion, let your student trace all over the roads with a red crayon showing where a crazy red carpet could go!

Discuss how police officers are community helpers. Cut out each page and each picture. Paste the pictures to the pages. Stack pages together with cover on top and staple as indicated.

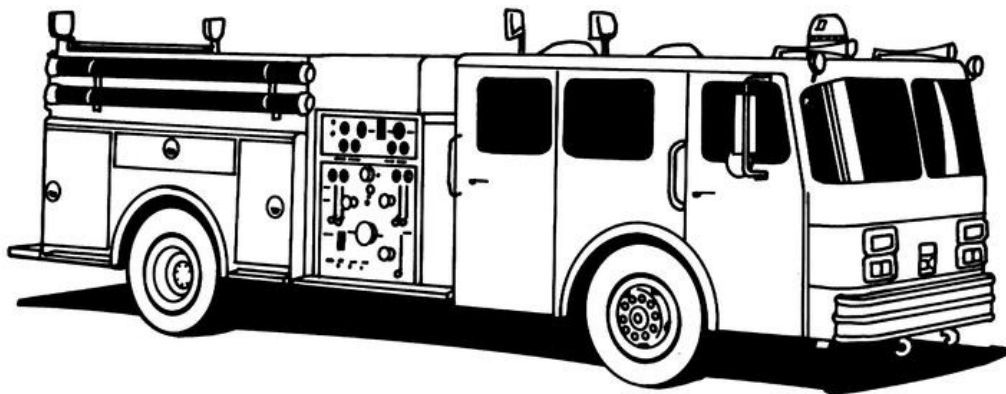
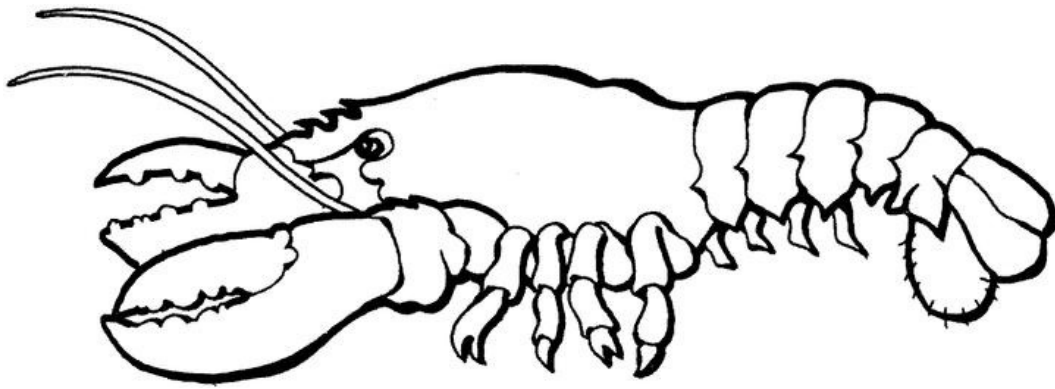
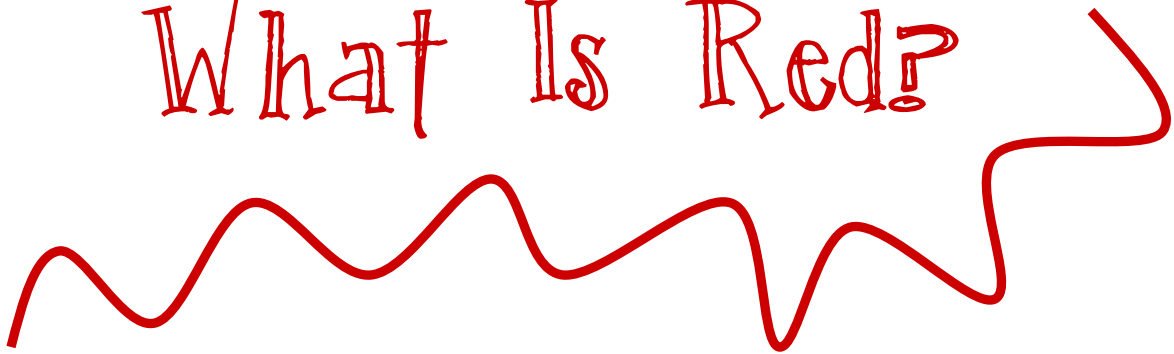

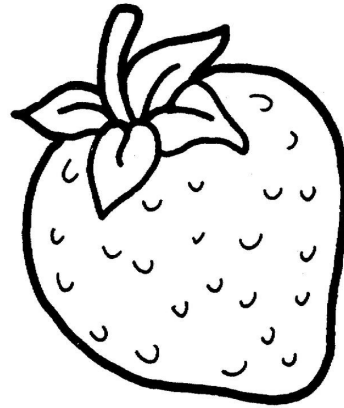
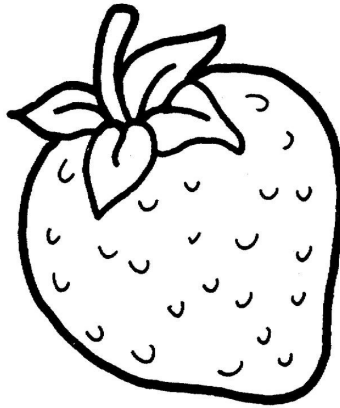
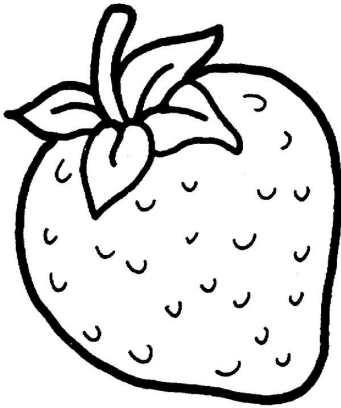
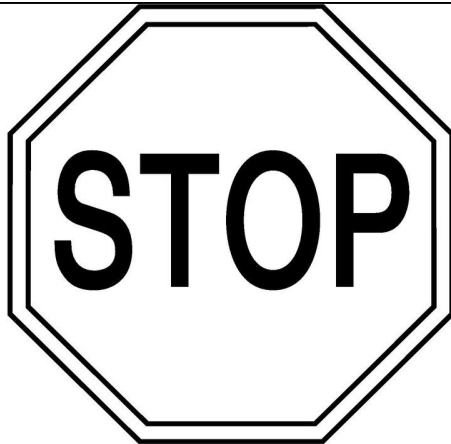
What is Red?

Glue this tab to the back of the next strip.

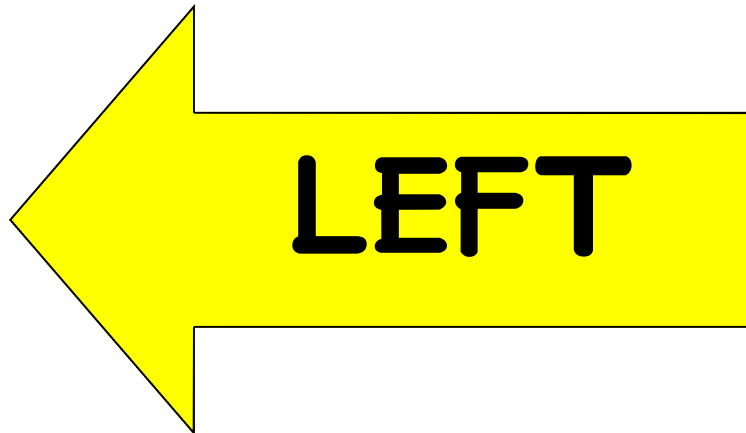
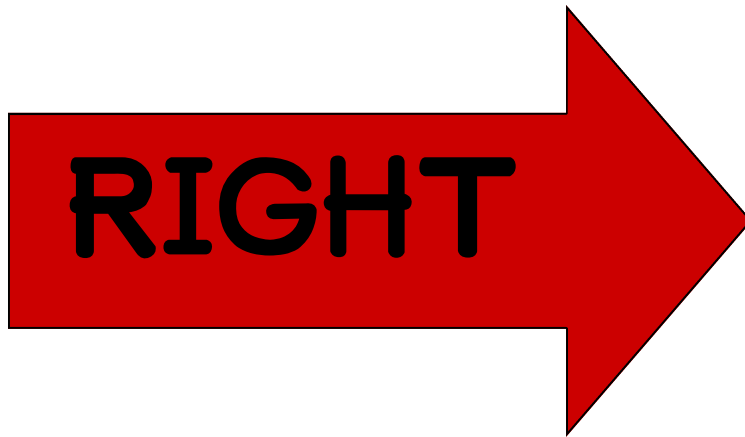


Continue the color learning fun by playing

Left and Right

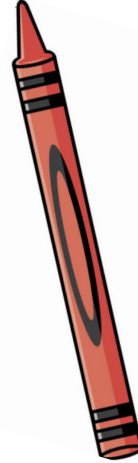
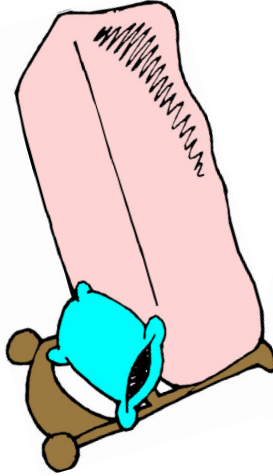

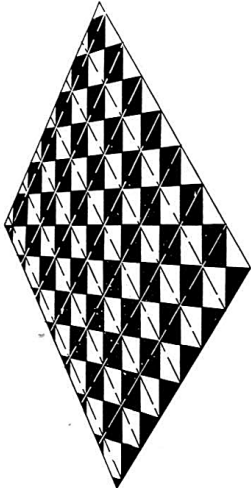
Rhyming Words

Cut on solid lines. Fold on dotted lines (like a pamphlet). Cut and paste the rhyming words under the flaps.

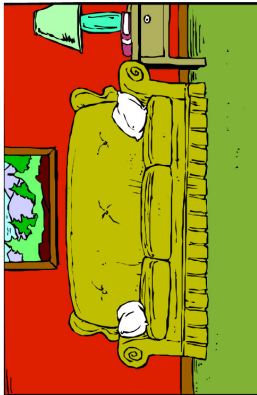
