
Comparing Times: To compare the time in the capital city to the time where you live, use this website: <u>The World Clock</u>

Animals in Vietnam: Picture cards are provided, but your student will need to research the animals in order to write facts on the cards.






Directions: Cut out book as one piece. Fold in half. Complete graph and paste inside the book.



Print on cardstock. Cut each piece out. Write one product on each piece. Stack together with cover on top and secure with a brass brad.






Cut out pages (10 total). Stack together with cover on top and staple on the left side of the book as indicated.




Cut books out and fold them in half. Help your student research these animals. Write information about the animals inside the books.
