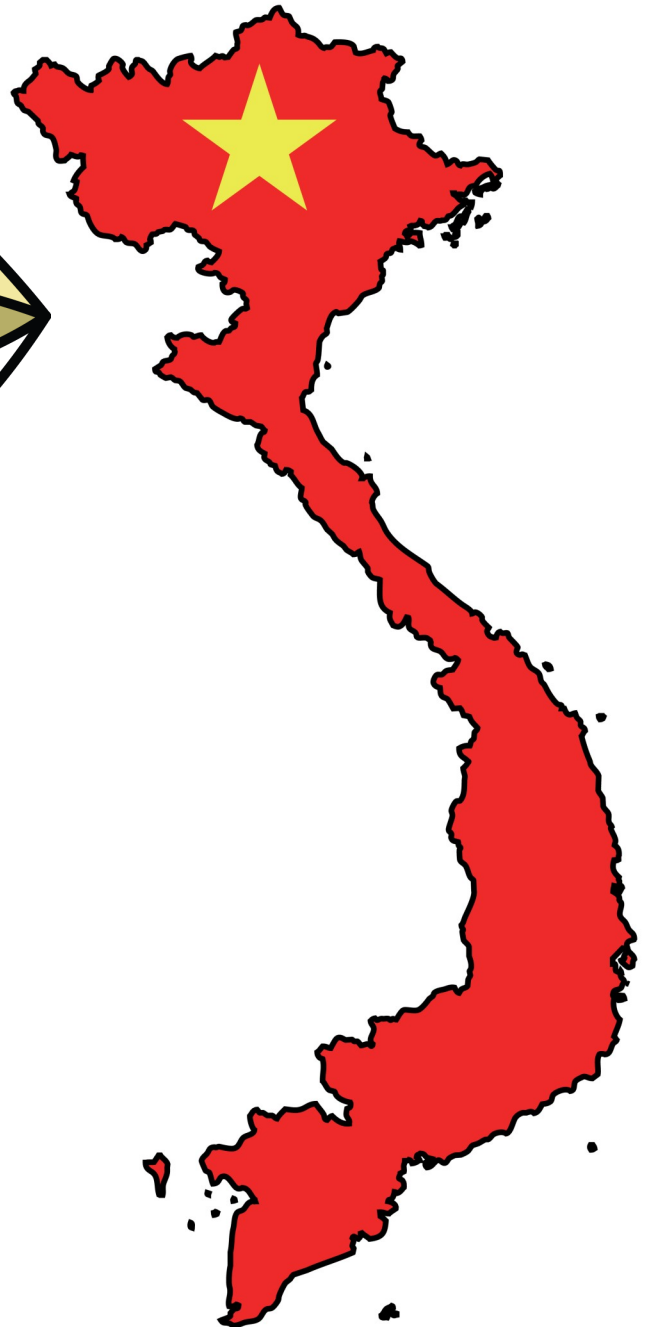

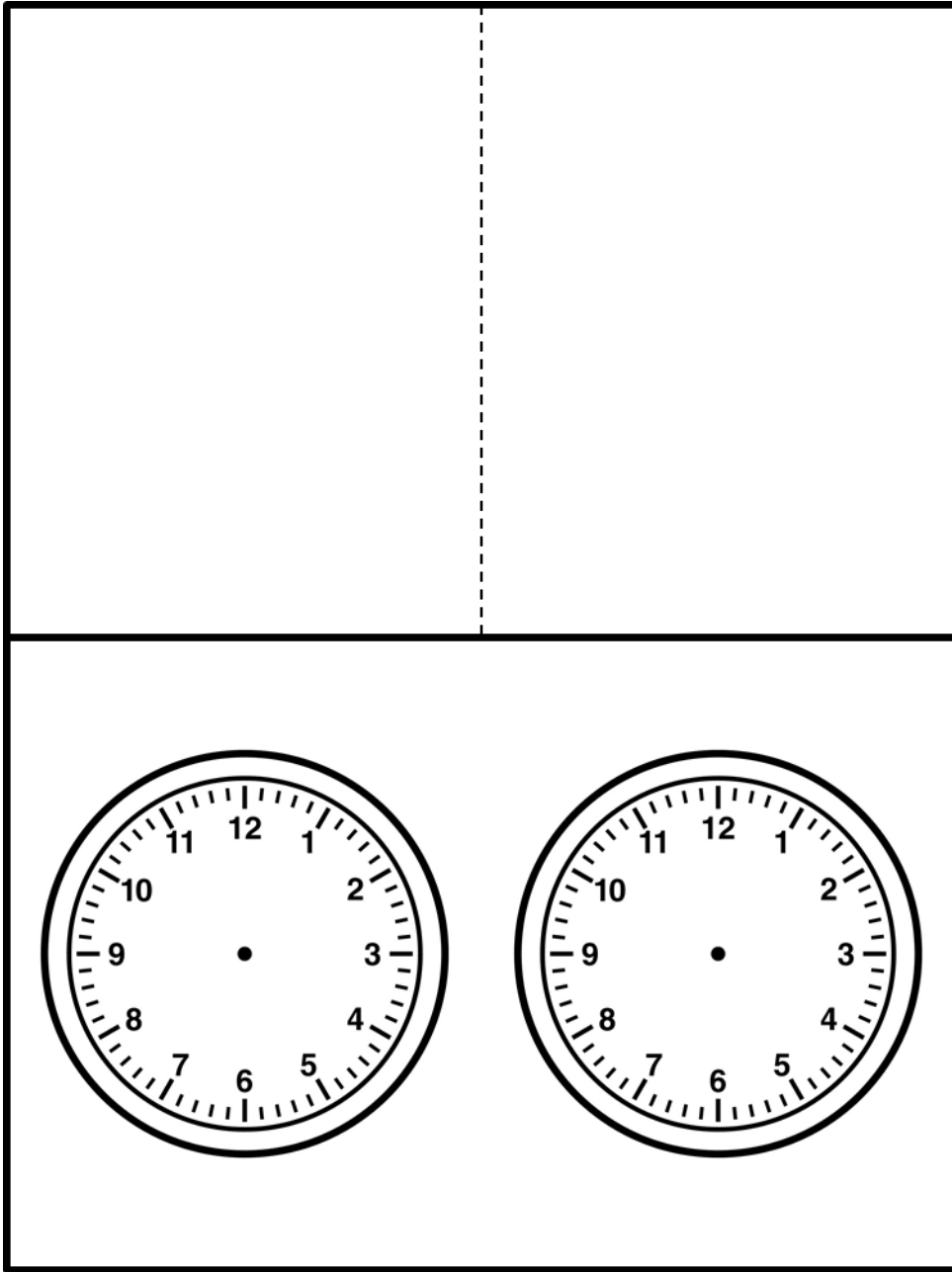
Sight Seeing Guide: Your student will need to research the cities in order to complete the mini-book.

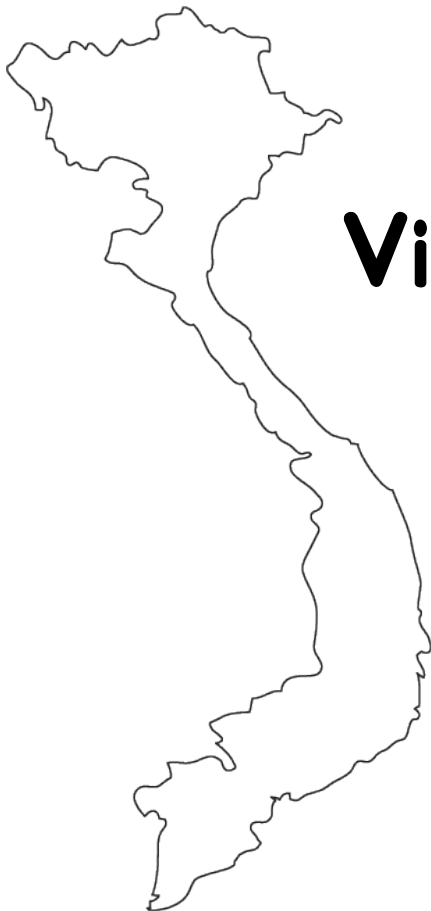
