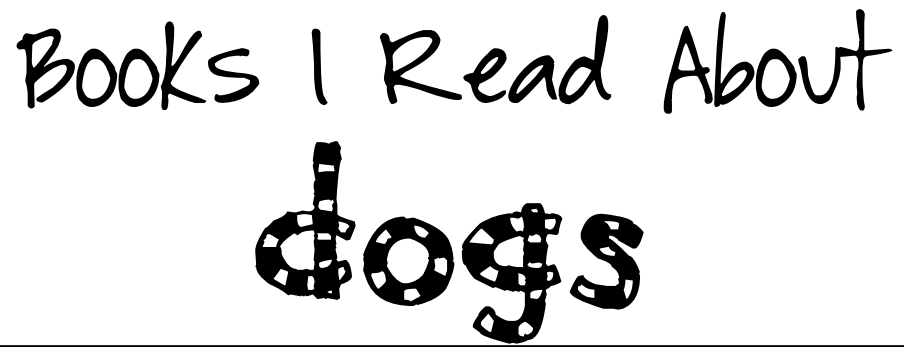

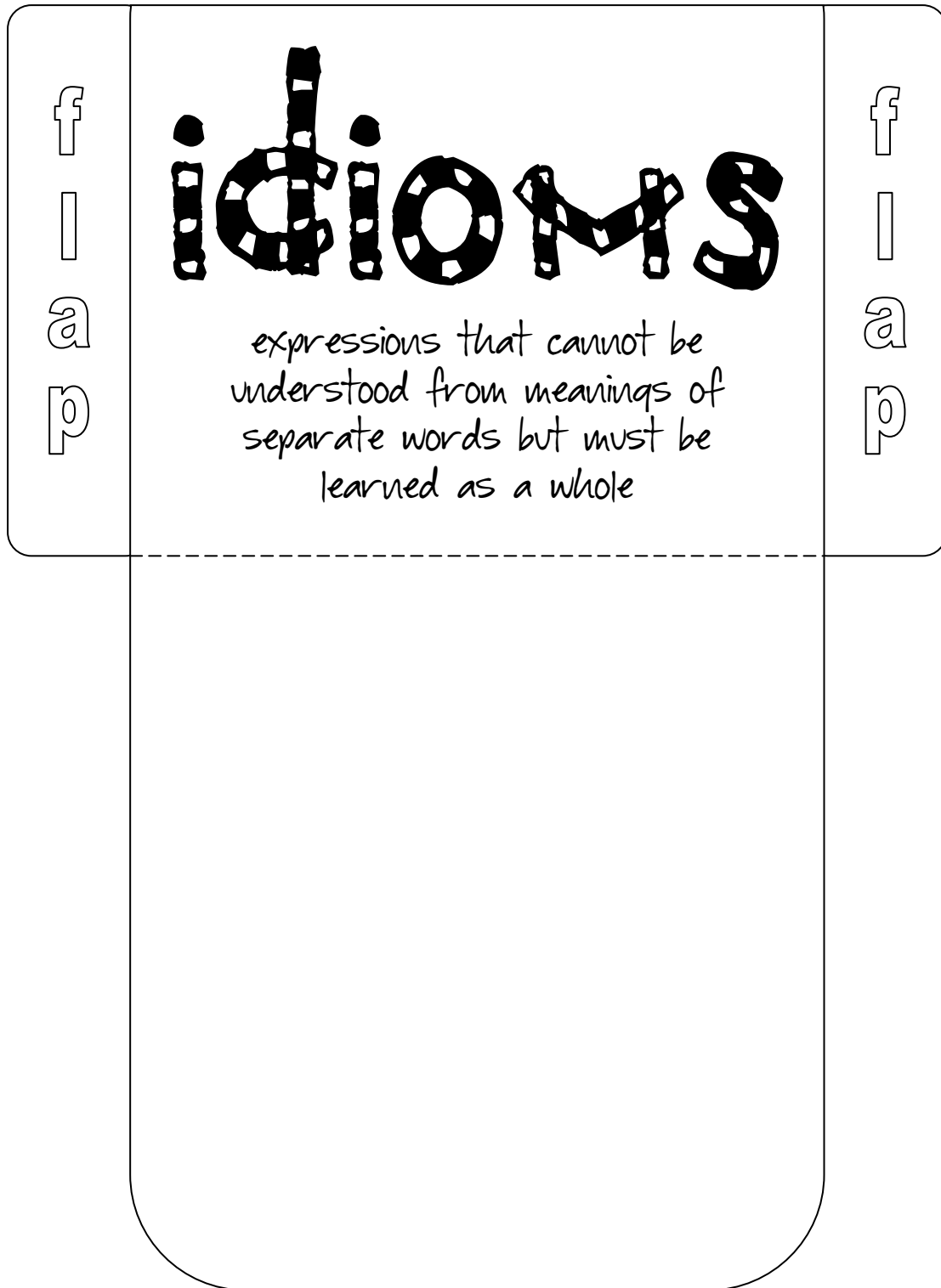

Cut pocket out as one piece. Fold back up. Wrap flaps around the back and glue down.

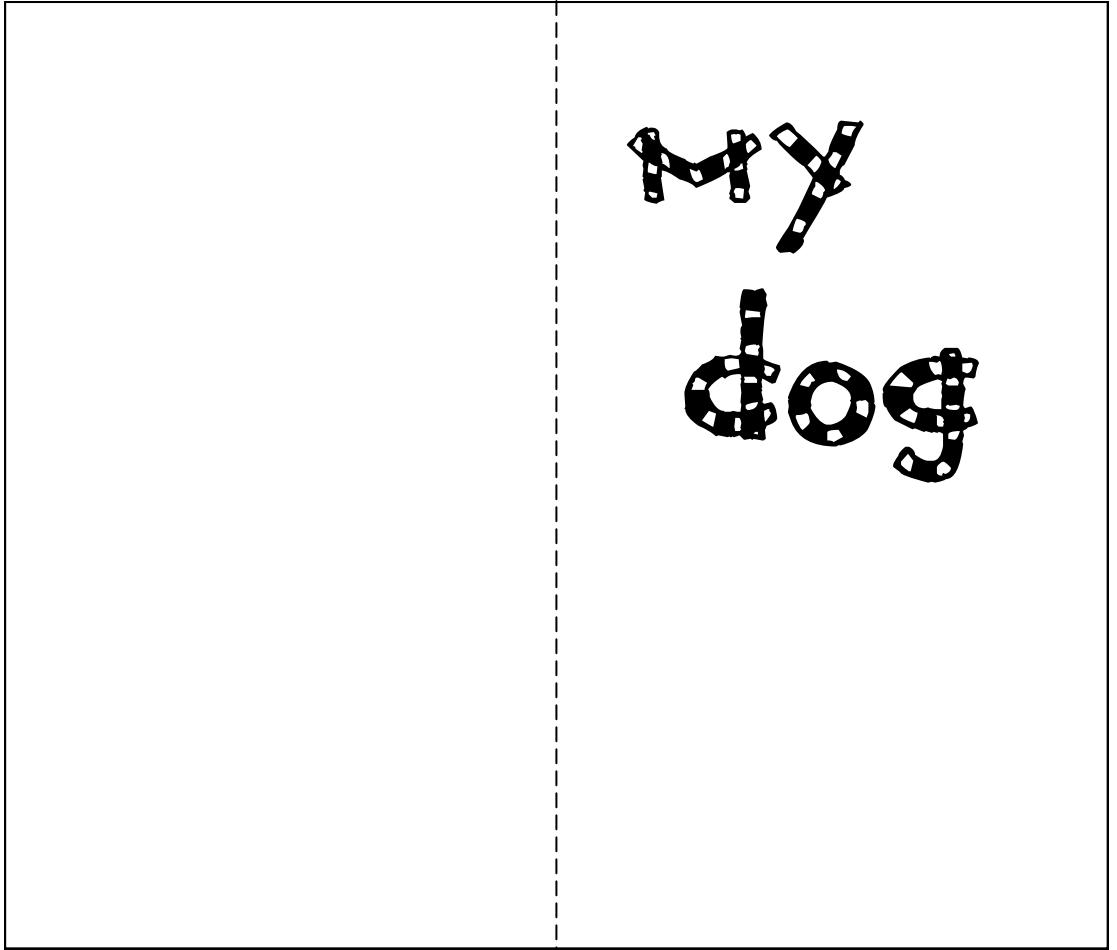
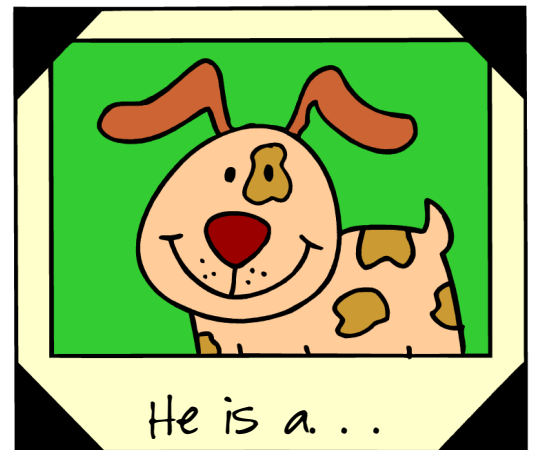
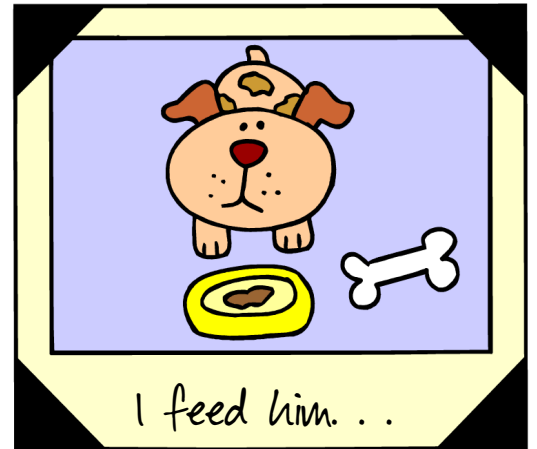
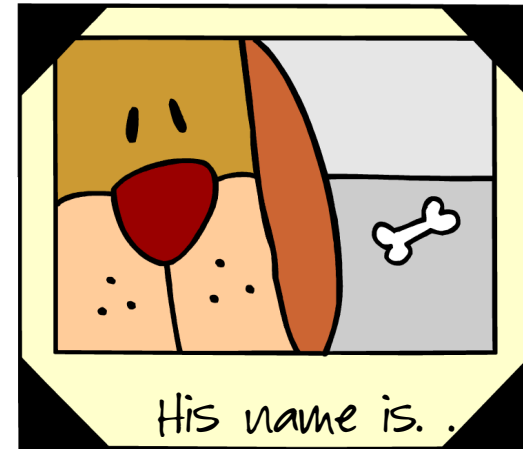
Week One Day One

Put glue on the very top (1/2 inch) of each "photo" and glue two on the left and two on the right of the inside of your book.

After the glue dries, flip them up and make a fold so that they are easy to lift.

Let your student write answers to the prompts under each photo.



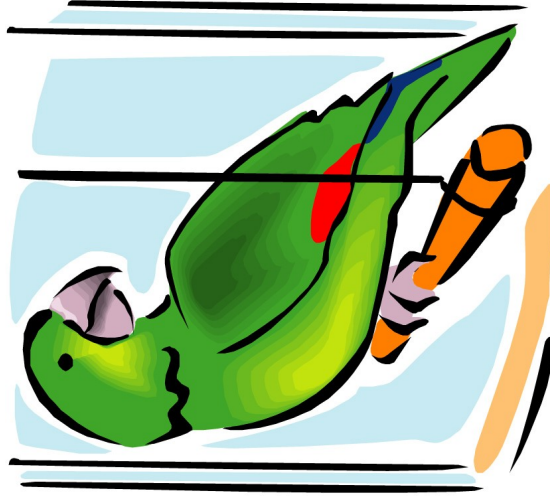
