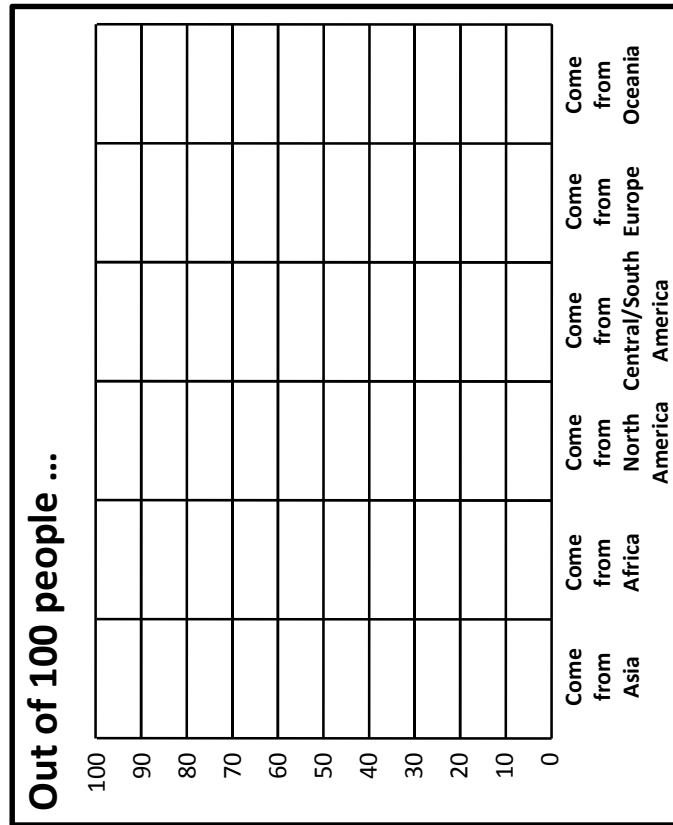

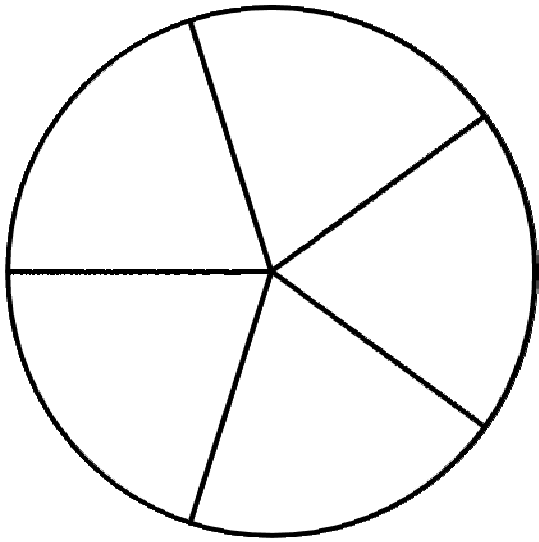

# Money



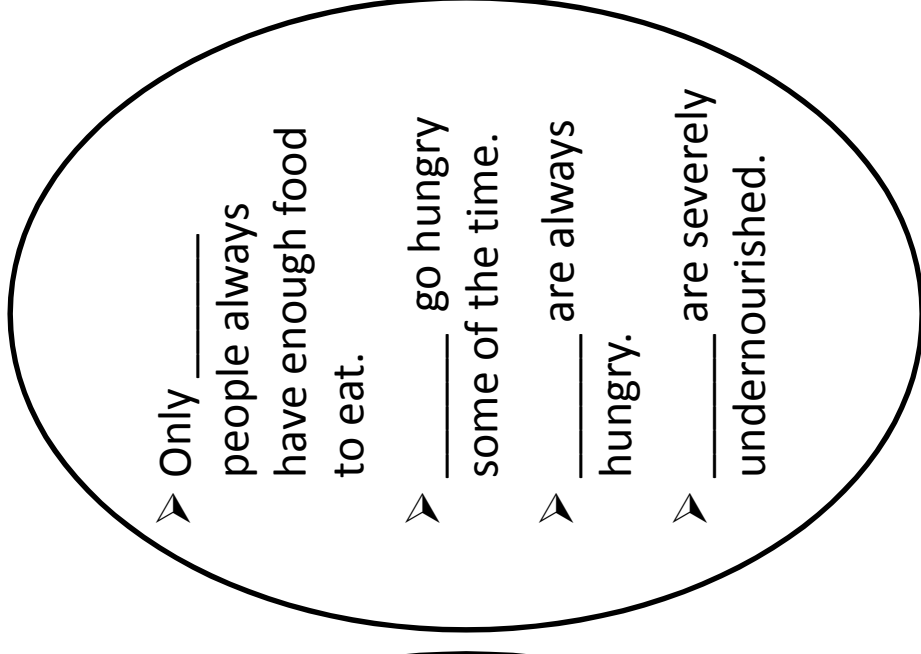
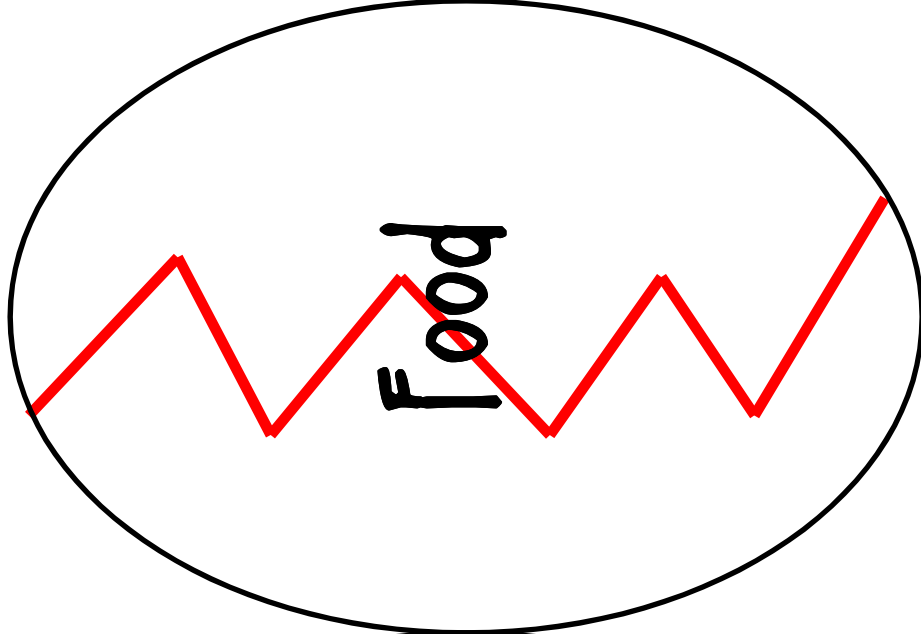
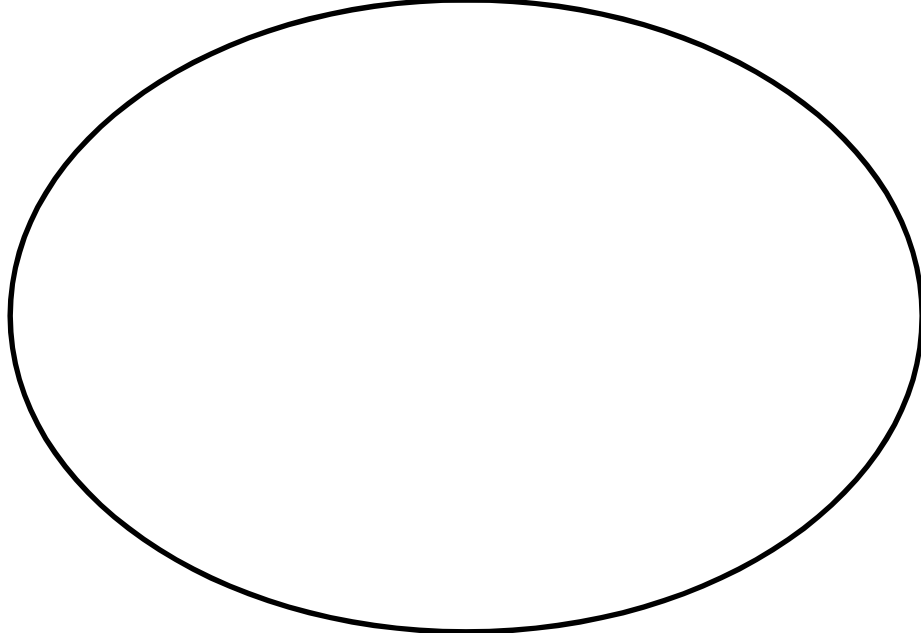
Richest 20 have extra money after paying for food and shelter to spend on other things.

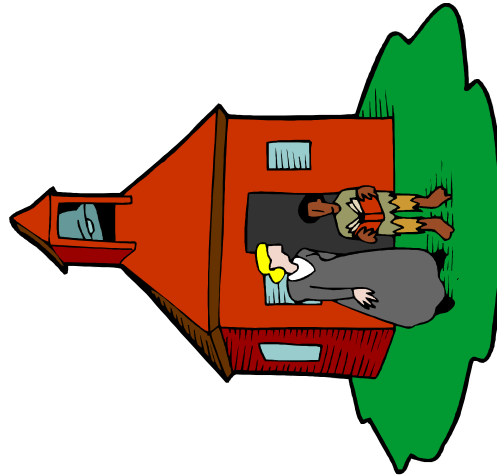

### **WHERE DO THEY LIVE?**

Out of the 100 people in our village ...

Out of 100 people, more than half would speak 1 of 8 languages ...

22 speak Chinese dialect

9 speak English

8 speak Hindi

3 speak Russian

3 speak Portuguese

### **HOW OLD ARE THEY?**

Out of the 100 people in our village ...

39 are under 20 years old

42 are between 20 and 49 years old

18 are between 50 and 79 years old

1 is 80 years old or over

### **WHICH RELIGIONS DO THEY PRACTICE?**

Out of the 100 people in our village ...

32 are Christian

19 are Muslim

13 are Hindu

12 practice folk religions like Animism and Shamanism

6 are Buddhist

1 is Jewish

15 don't practice any organized religion

### **EDUCATION**

Out of the 100 people in our village ...

38 are children of school age. And of those 38, 31 actually go to school and learn to read and write while 7 don't have a school to go to, some work in fields and factories to feed families, and some are girls who have to stay home to help.

### **MONEY**

Of the 100 people in our village ...

The richest 20 have extra money after paying for food and shelter to spend on other things.

The poorest 20 make almost nothing, barely enough to survive.

The other 60 people make something in between. So most of the people, many of them children, do whatever they can to make enough money to eat.

### **FOOD**

Out of the 100 people in our village ...

Only 24 always have enough food to eat.

16 go hungry some of the time.

34 are always hungry.

26 are severely undernourished.

### **WATER**

Out of the 100 people in our village ...

75 would have clean, safe water either in their homes or close by.

25 would not and have to spend a large part of each day simply getting clean, safe water. Usually, it's girls and women who do this job.

### **AIR**

Out of the 100 people in our village ...

68 breathe clean air.

32 breathe air that is unhealthy because of pollution.

### **ELECTRICITY**

Out of the 100 people in our village ...

76 of them have electricity but mostly just for lights.

### **TECHNOLOGY**

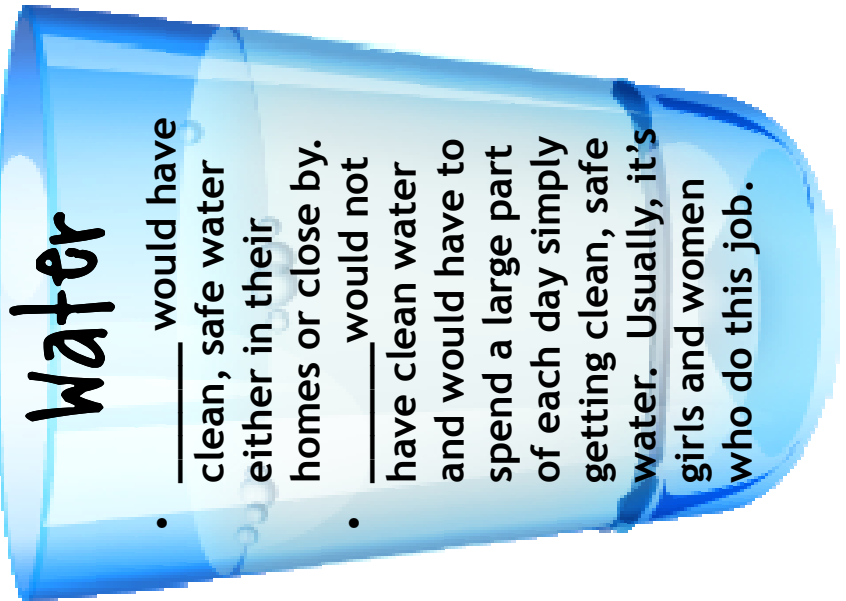
Out of the 100 people in our village ...

There are 42 radios, 24 televisions (not necessarily in 24 homes), and 10 computers.

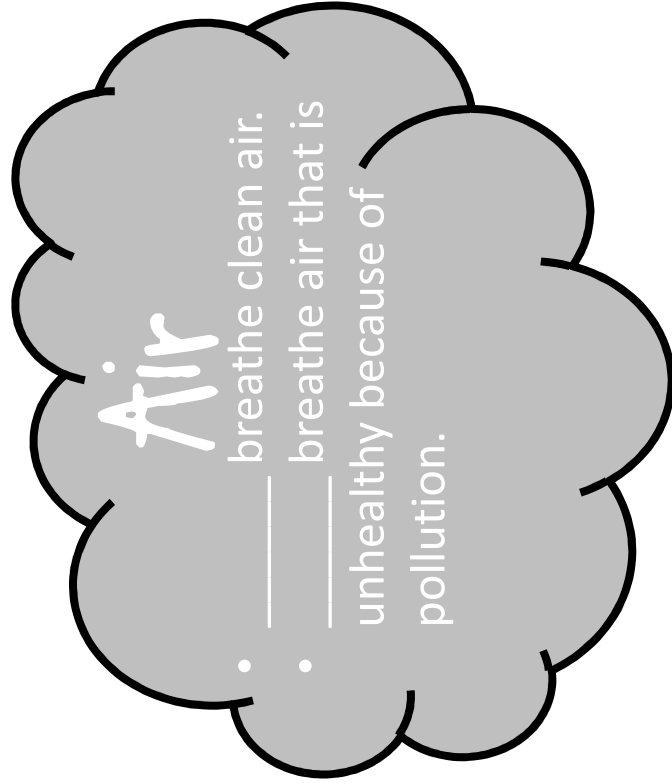
### **DOMESTICATED ANIMALS**

Out of the 100 people in our village ...

There are 31 sheep and goats; 23 cows, bulls and oxen; 15 pigs; 3 camels; 2 horses, and, 189 chickens.
