If you have two pieces of information, try

- Flap Book with 2 Flaps
- Any Shutterfold Book
- 3 Circle Book
- Shutter Tied Book

If you are comparing and contrasting something, try

- Compare & Contrast Matchbook
- Venn Diagram Flap Book

If you have three pieces of information, try

- Tab Book (3 tabs)
- Flap Book with 3 Flaps
- Any Tri-fold Book
- Triangle Petal Book
- Graduated Book (3 segments plus cover)

If you have **four** pieces of information, try

- T-book with 4 spaces

If you have five pieces of information, try

- Pentagon Petal Book
- Tab Book (5 tabs)
- T-book with 5 spaces
- Graduated Book 5 sections plus cover
- Any Stapled Shape Book

If you have **six** pieces of information, try

- Any Fan Book
- Hexagon Petal Book
- Graduated Book 6 sections plus cover
- Shutter Flap Book (6 areas)
- Tab Book (6 tabs)
- Any Stapled Shape Book
- Flap Book with 6 Flaps
- Hot Dog Book
- <u>Three Square Unfolding Book</u>

If you have **seven** pieces of information, try

- Any Fan Book
- Any Stapled Shape Book
- A Pocket with Cards
- Graduated Book 7 sections plus cover
- Flap Book with 7 Flaps

If you have **eight** pieces of information, try

- Any Fan Book
- Any Stapled Shape Book
- A Pocket with Cards
- Flag Book
