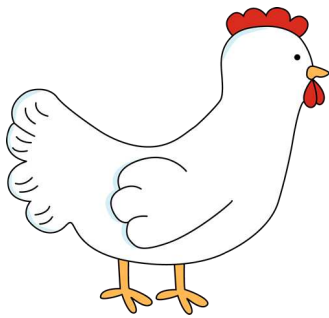
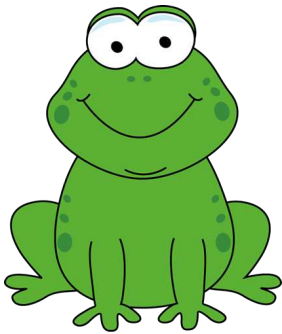
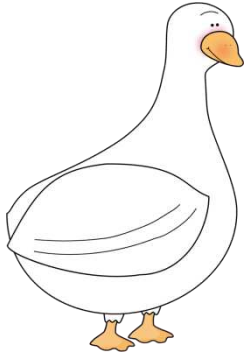
Feed the Animals!

Cut apart the number cards.

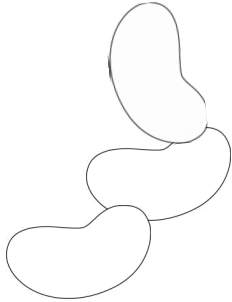
Place a number card next to each animal. Your student should then place the correct amount of jelly beans for each animal in the third column.





Jellybean Graph

Print the next page.

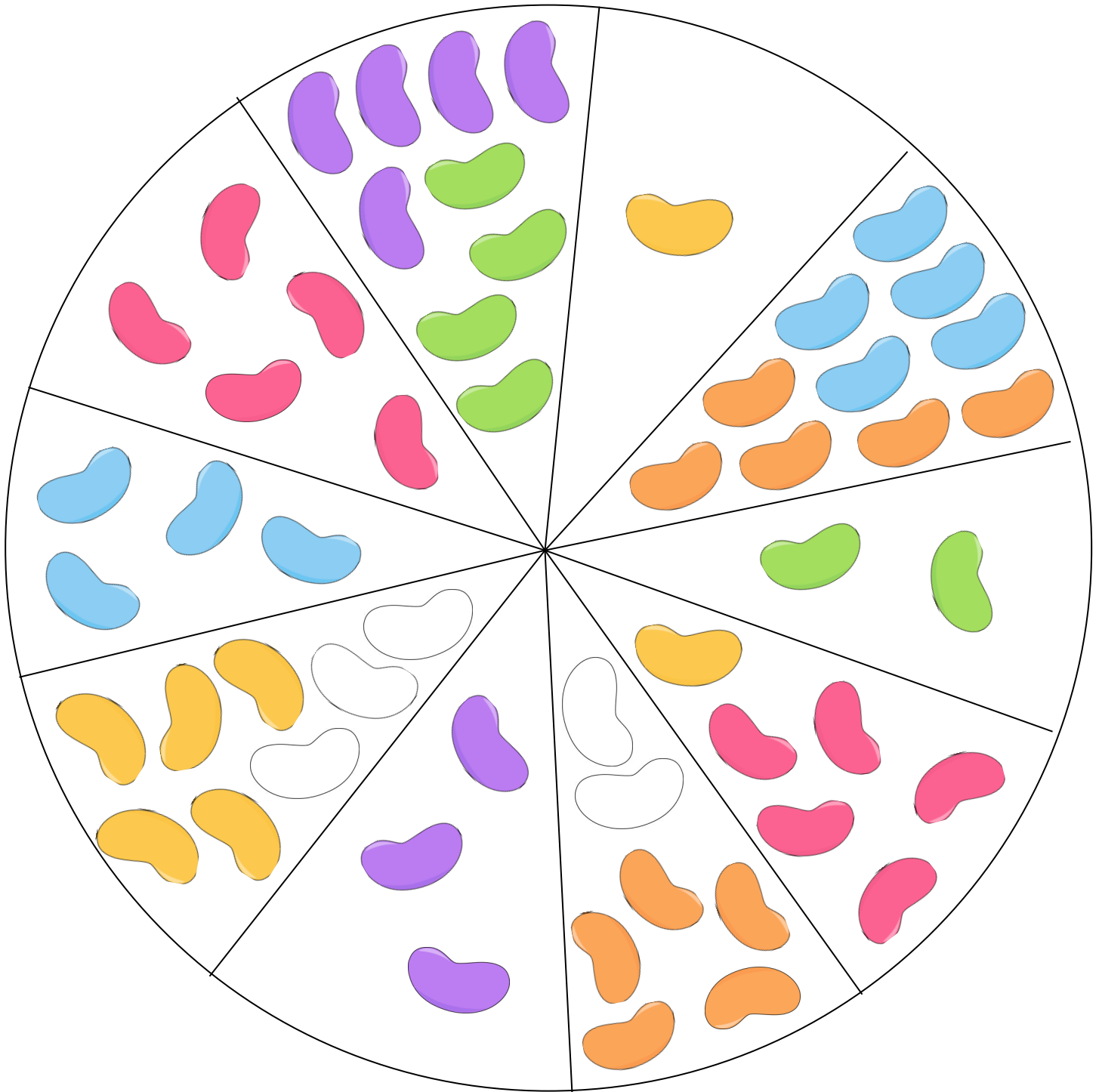
Give your student 35 jellybeans (six different colors). Have your student color the six colors on the beans at the bottom of the page (1 orange bean, 1 white bean, etc.).
