A few days later the Shepherd Boy again shouted, "Wolf! Wolf!" Again the Villagers ran to help him, only to be laughed at again.

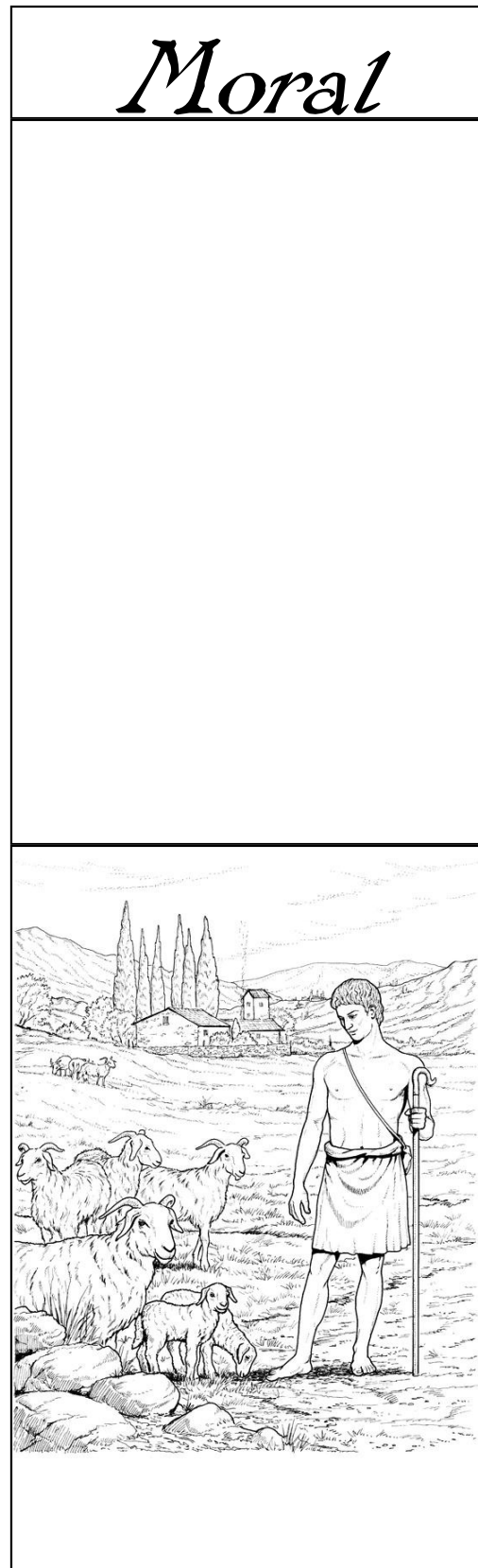
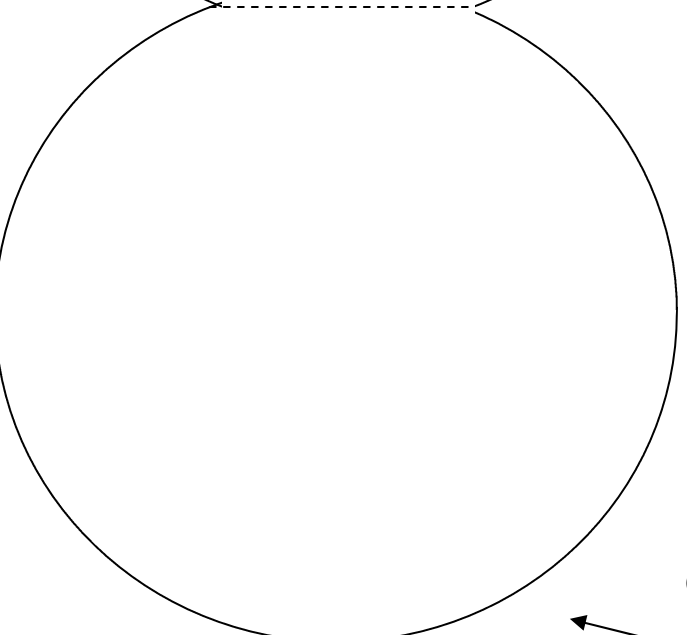
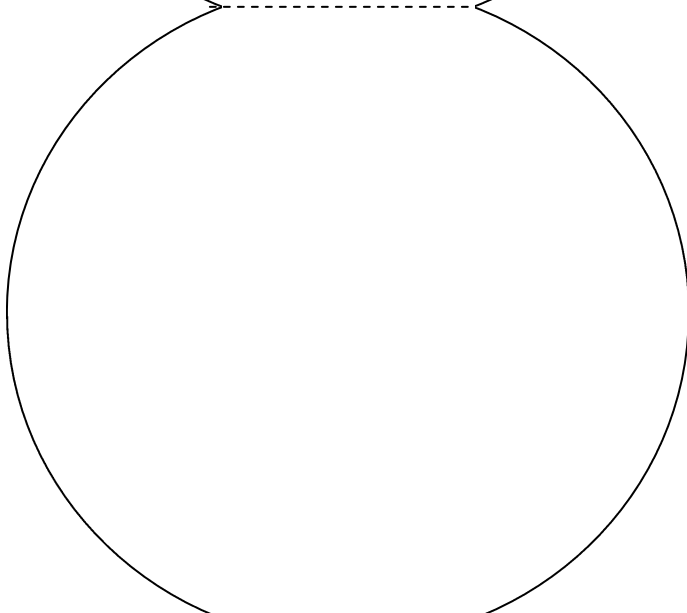
Then one evening as the sun was setting behind the forest and the shadows were creeping out over the pasture, a Wolf

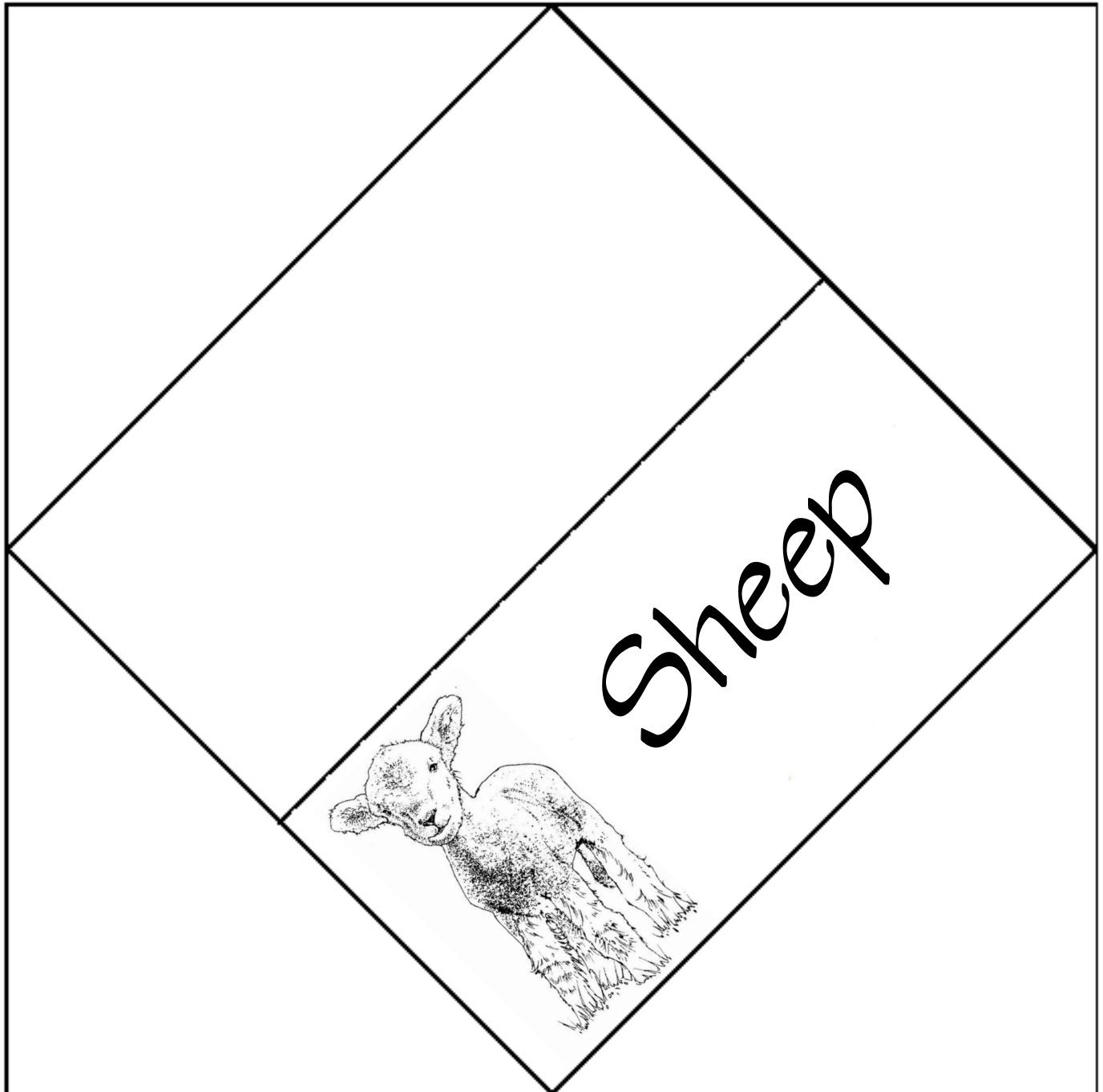
The Wolf killed a great many of the Boy's sheep and then slipped away into the forest.

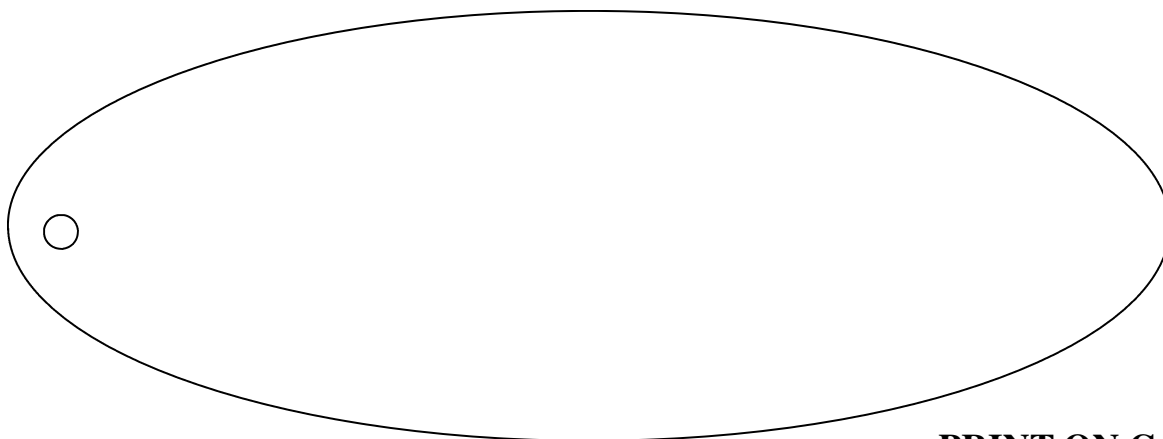


Cut out matchbook as one piece and fold.

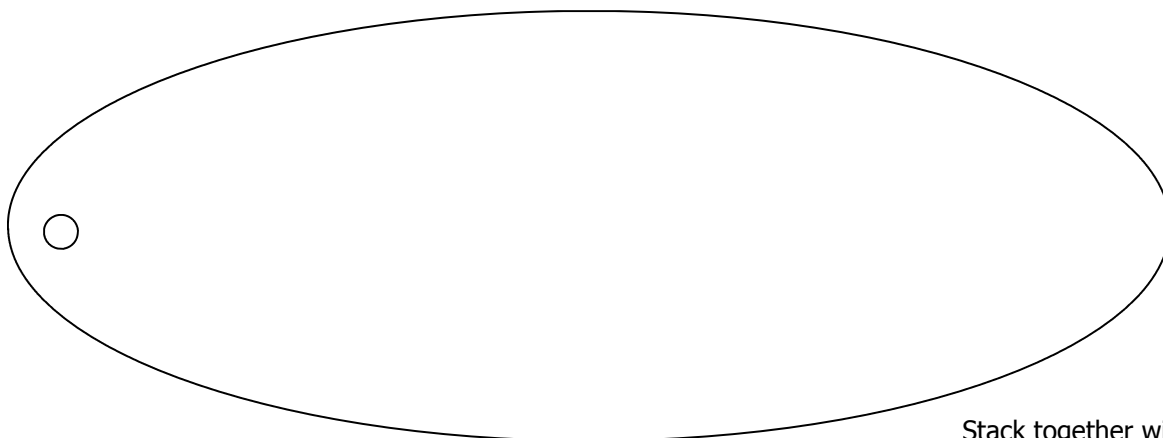
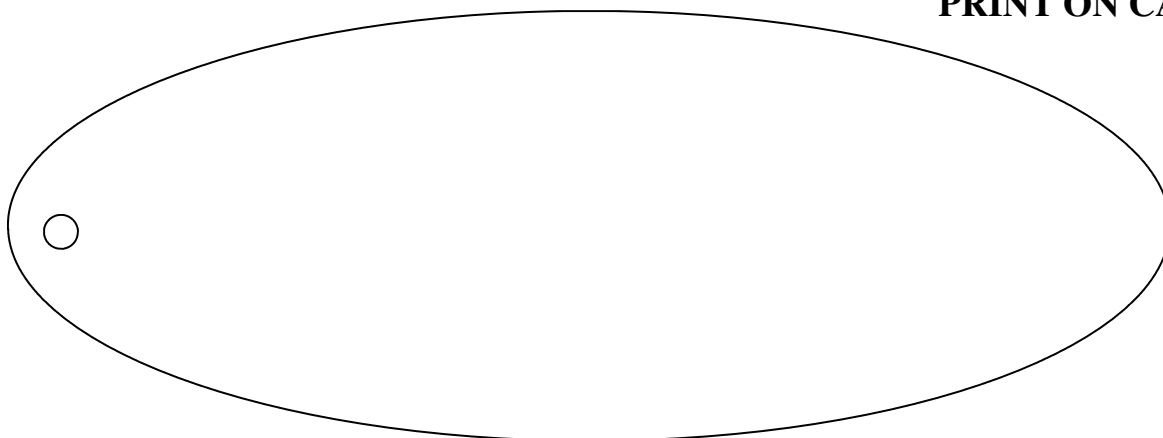
Cut out book as one piece. Fold like an accordion.



Cut out book as one piece. Fold each triangle under. Fold book in half. On the outer flaps write questions about sheep. Answer the questions under the flaps.



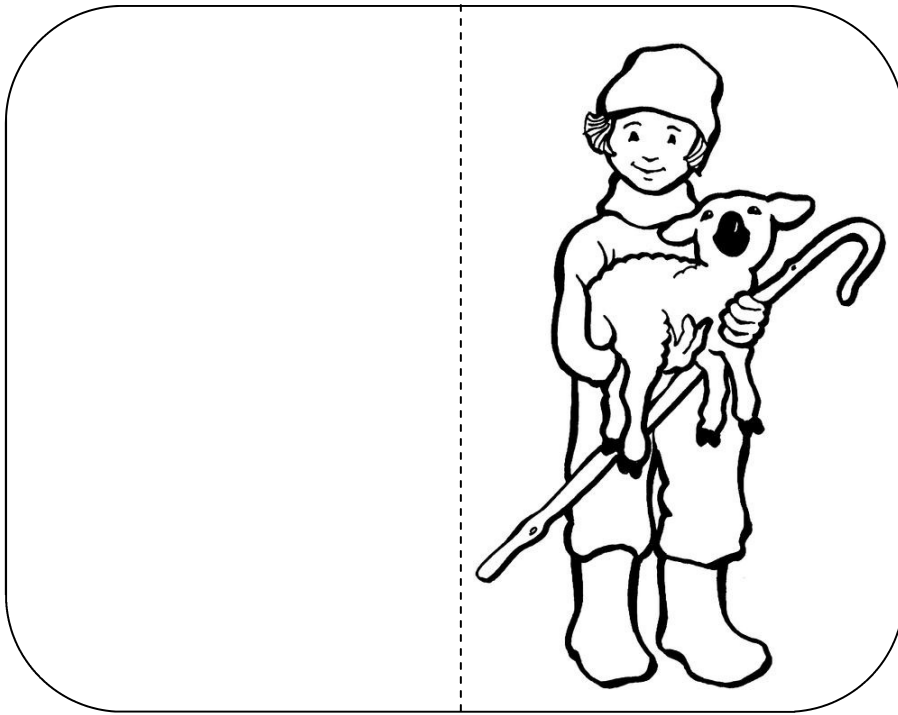
PRINT ON CARDSTOCK
