

Pages 3-5: Super Hero Profiles (creative thinking, literacy, handwriting practice)

Let your student tell you all about these three super heroes.

Page 6: Super Hero Positional Words (learning positional words, following directions)

Page 7: Super Hero Calendar (days of the week)

If you are using this unit for one week, use this calendar as an introduction to the days of the week for your student. Each day, let your student stick one star sticker on the calendar.

Page 8: Sticker Page for Super Heroes (fine motor)

Print on a full sheet label, if you can. If not, just print on paper and use glue to stick things on the pages.

Page 9: Super Hero Zoom Through the Alphabet (ABC recognition)

Use the letter stickers from page 8 to complete this page. When you are finished, sing the alphabet song together. You can also use this page to review letter sounds. Point to a letter and ask your student what sound it makes! After this is complete, you can laminate it, and your student can use a dry erase marker to trace over the letters.

Page 10: Which Super Hero is Hiding the Star? (number recognition, counting)

Cut the cards apart. Hide the extra star sticker under one of the cards. Your student should guess which one it's under by calling out a number name. Continue until your student has found it. Let your student hide the star from you. Play a few rounds, but try to stop before your student is bored with this.

Page 11: Be a Super Kid! (learning about rules, making habits)

Think of some rules of your home or some habits your student needs to master. Type them on the page. Print the page and laminate it. Let your student check off the rules he obeys/tasks he completes each day.

Page 12: Stars for Heroes (fine motor, determining what a hero is)

Page 13: Tally Marks (counting, counting by 5s)

Using a scrap piece of paper, show your student what tally marks are. Grab some simple objects from around your house and show how your student how to count them with tally marks. Complete the page together.

Pages 14-15: ABC Magnet Word Building

Use your alphabet magnets and a cookie sheet to build the words! If you have Montessori ABC letters, you can use page 14.






