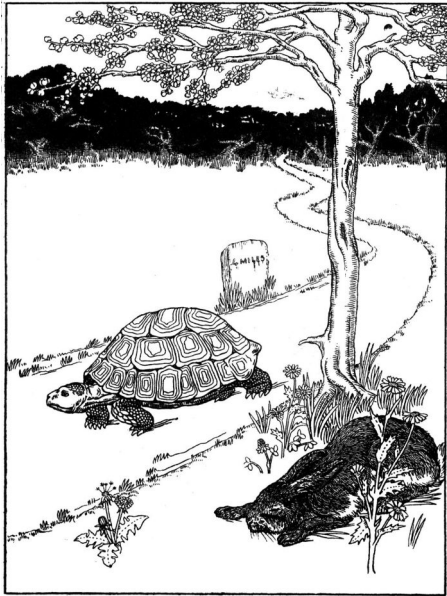


The Hare and the Tortoise

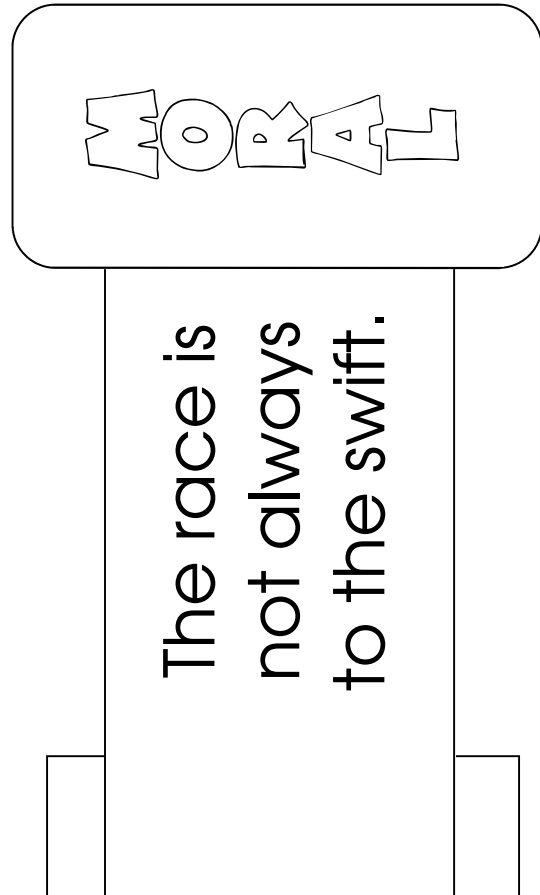
Cut out story. Fold in half on dotted line. Glue the back of the bottom to your page. the back of the entire cover. Glue part of it to the page and part of it folded story.

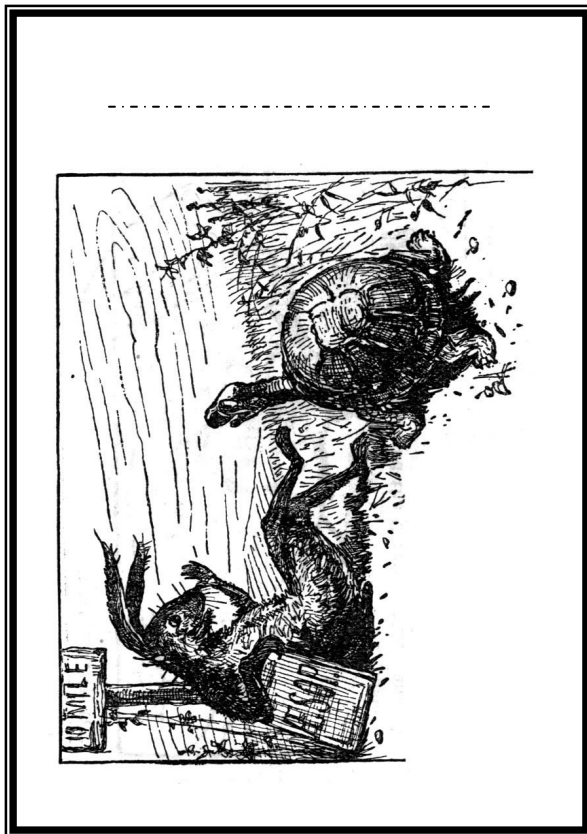

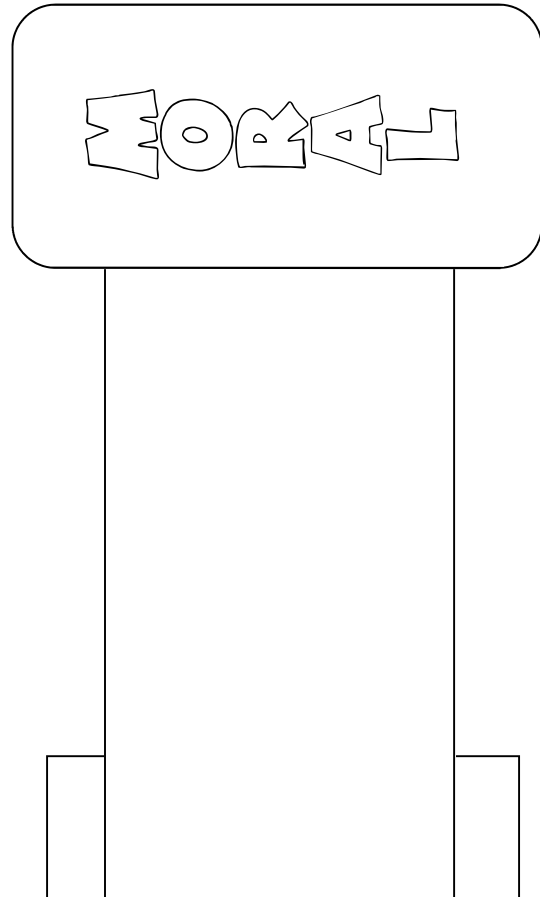
